A LETTER FROM THE OWNERS



Welcome to the new, Phoenix Rising Soccer Complex. As a member of the crowd tonight, you are part of a new era for professional soccer in Arizona, and we are grateful that you have chosen to be a part of it.

From the moment we assembled our new ownership group, we knew that Phoenix was a prime market for an MLS expansion team. Across the board, Phoenix is No. 1 in key demographics vs. the other 11 cities vying for an expansion club (population, future population, Millennials and Hispanic populations). There also isn't an MLS club within 300 miles of Phoenix, which is another example of the need for MLS to come to the Valley.

The only aspect of our bid that we didn't have a chance to showcase yet was the fan support. We knew it was here, and we knew that fans like you were excited to watch high-quality professional soccer. And, you have not let us down!

In our first three home matches of 2017, we've had standing room only crowds totaling more than 19,000 fans in attendance - three straight sellouts! At our last match, a thrilling 4-3 win over Swope Park Rangers (a team that had not lost a match in its past 14 appearances), we set a new club record for attendance with 7,162 fans.

Two weeks ago, we also welcomed international soccer legend Didier Drogba as our new co-owner and player, another exciting new benefit to our MLS bid. We also recently announced that Goldman Sachs would be our structuring agent for the construction of a new, MLS stadium, which means we will build a high quality, soccer-specific stadium without asking taxpayers for financial assistance.

But, your support is still the most exciting part of this young 2017 season. Your continued passion in the stands is truly most important to show MLS, we are ready for Division One soccer in Phoenix.
