Items on the list to be completed:

*Sod will be replaced on College City field and also added behind home plate by the backstop

*Shed maintenance

*1st National batting cage nets – it was also suggested that a mat be added behind the catcher's end of the cage and padded to the posts near the pitcher's end

Items discussed as possible wish list items:

- *New pitching rubbers in cages (Lance)
- *Turf in batting cages
- *Finish fence markers
- *Replace scoreboards with wireless version (similar to Babcock - \$5000 each) (long term)
- *Field behind Post (long term)
