PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Tots: Age appropriate games and activities designed to engage young players while on the soccer field. Parents are welcome and encouraged to be on the field with their "partner" or child. Activities designed to increase agility and coordination. There will be a high degree of repetition from week to week to increase familiarity and comfort. Players need shin pads, water, and a size 3 ball.

Kindergarten

These Sunday afternoon one-hour clinics introduce young soccer players to a fun, interactive and skills-driven way to play soccer, building and advancing everything learned in the younger programs. The program is designed to develop a positive relationship with the game, build confidence and comfort with the ball at their feet, and help kids feel successful through small group exercises for about 45-50 minutes followed by short 10-15 minute game each week. Each child will need sneakers or cleats, a size 3 soccer ball, shin pads and a water bottle.

1st Grade & 2nd Grade Clinic: We have switched up the structure of these age groups. For this spring, we will be adding MORE scrimmaging to the hour (20 minutes vs 10 to 15 before). This section will remain co-ed clinic. This 6-week game-focused clinic will introduce technical aspects of the game (more so to the 2nd graders, less so to the 1st graders) such as goal and corner kicks, throw-ins and defensive and offensive play while building endurance on a larger field. Typical format for the hour will be 20 minutes training (dribbling, passing), then 20 minutes of game play (which could be for example "get out of here") and then a 20 minute scrimmage to finish up. Each child will need sneakers or cleats, a size 4 soccer ball, shin pads and a water bottle.
