Was in Seattle, Washington area last weekend helping at USA Hockey's Pacific District Goaltending Development. I was one of the goalie development coordinators invited to be part of the camp. (Mike MacMillan was also there).

This new breed of goalie development camp is part of USA Hockey's ongoing commitment to youth goaltending development across the United States. They are also doing a camp like this in Cleveland area in August.

The camp was similar to a Dave Peterson Camp except they also invited the goalie parents and their individual goalie coaches to be part of the three-day event.

Camp was led Phil Osaer, goaltending manager for USA Hockey's American Development Model, Kevin Reiter, national goaltending coach, and USA Hockey goaltending development coordinators.

The 13th Minnesota Hockey Dave Peterson CCM High Performance Goalie Camp is set for Aug. 3-6 at St. Cloud State. We anticipate another sold-out camp with 25 boys and 25 girls. The girls side is full, as of Tuesday night, we have two spots left for boys. Tom Peart is general manager of the camp.

Phil Osaer, goaltending manager for USA Hockey's American Development Model, is scheduled to be one of the coaches at the camp.

Will begin invite coaches and lining up off-ice presenters in the next month or so.

Still working on finding two male counselors, but right now, Lauren Bench (Burnsville) Bemidji State, and Ashley Corcoran, (Red Wing) St. Mary's University have agreed to be the female counselors.

Working with Mike Terwilliger to schedule a series of goalie skill development practices this fall. This will be second year Minnesota Hockey has offered these programs. Last year, sessions were held in Apple Valley, Brooklyn Park, Edina and South St. Paul. Received positive feedback from participants. I think cost was \$50 for a 90-minute session.

Working with Mike Terwilliger to schedule two High Performance Goalie Coaching Workshops this October in Duluth and Brooklyn Park. Phil Osaer has indicated he wants to be a part of the workshops. We held a workshop like this last December and had about 40 coaches. Osear and Mike MacMillan were part of the staff in 2016.

Might also connect with North Dakota Hockey to have a goalie coaching clinic and possible youth goalie clinic in the Fargo-area during that time frame. Would likely invited MN Hockey coaches and goalies to participate as well.
