



Elkhorn Flag Football 2017

Regular Season & Post Season Format

Kindergarten:

Regular Season: Teams will all be in the Leaders Division. Each team will play a 6 game minimum regular season. Every team will play games against each of the other teams. Kindergarten games will not keep score.

Post Season: Each team will receive a final game on Sunday, October 22nd.

1st Grade / 3rd Grade / 4th Grade / 5th Grade:

Regular Season: Teams will be divided into 2 separate divisions, Leaders and Legends. Each team will play a 6 game minimum regular season. Every team will play games against each of the teams within their division, as well as teams from outside of their division. The only games that will count for or against each teams' regular season record are the games against the teams from within their division.

Post Season: Each team will receive a final game on Sunday, October 22nd. The 2 teams that win their divisions will play for the league championship on that day. All other teams will be matched up against an opponent of similar strength / ability.

2nd Grade:

Regular Season Teams will be divided into 3 separate divisions. Each team will play a 6 game minimum regular season. Every team will play games against each of the teams within their division, as well as teams from outside of their division. The only games that will count for or against each teams' regular season record are the games against the other teams from within their division.

Post Season: Each team will receive a final game on Sunday, October 22nd. The 3 teams that win their divisions will play for the league championship on that day. The top seed of the 3 division champions will receive a Bye to the championship game and the #2 and #3 seed will play earlier in the day for the chance to move onto the league championship game. Seeding will be determined by each teams' regular season point differential (+15 maximum per game). All other teams will be matched up against an opponent of similar strength / ability.

8th Grade:

Regular Season: Teams will all be in the Leaders Division. Each team will play a 6 game minimum regular season. Every team will play games against each of the other teams 2x each.

Post Season: Each team will receive a final game on Sunday, October 22nd. The top two teams based on regular season standings will play one another the final day for the league championship. All other teams will be matched up against an opponent of similar strength / ability.
