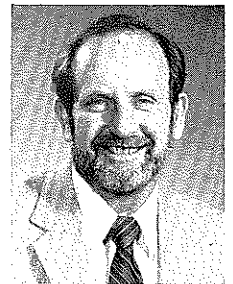

"GAME OF THE WEEK" FEATURES #5 PLU, #2 LINFIELD

ABOUT TONIGHT'S GAME: Tonight's contest between Pacific Lutheran and Linfield—the season-opener for both—might well be billed the NAIA "Game of the Week." And the Tacoma Dome provides a special setting for a special game. The host Lutes are ranked No. 5 in the NAIA Division II Top 25 national poll, while Linfield is the No. 2-ranked squad in the country. Since 1980, these two schools have combined for five national titles and nine total championship game appearances.

THE SERIES: This is the 43rd meeting between the Lutes and the Wildcats since the first game in 1933 . . . Linfield owns a 23-16-3 series lead . . . the schools met each year from 1933-41, then resumed the series in 1965 and have played at least once each year since . . . PLU's last victory in the series came in 1991 when the Lutes dumped the Wildcats 23-0 in a national quarterfinal playoff game . . . Linfield's last win in the series, 44-30 last year, also came in a quarterfinal playoff tilt . . . PLU has twice won three in a row against Linfield (1939-41, 1990-91 two wins) . . . the Wildcats' won six straight from 1970-75 . . . PLU's largest victory margin in the series is 38 points (45-7 in 1940) . . . Linfield's largest victory margin is 26 points (43-17 in 1986) . . . three PLU season openers have come against Linfield, with the Wildcats taking two victories (20-6 in 1933 and 17-0 in 1965) and PLU one (9-8 in 1991).

LAST MEETING(S): Linfield took 14-7 and 44-30 victories over the Lutes last year . . . both games were played in McMinnville, the second coming in the NAIA national quarterfinals.

1992 RECORDS: Pacific Lutheran finished the 1992 season with a 9-2 record, including a 5-0 mark to win the Columbia Football Association's Mt. Rainier League title . . . Linfield finished 12-1 and won the CFA's Mt. Hood League title with a 6-0 record.

THE COACHES: PLU's **Frosty Westering** (Nebraska-Omaha '52) is in his 22nd season at PLU, where he holds a 169-45-3 record. The NAIA's winningest active coach, his overall record is 215-72-5 in 28 years. Westering is 11-15 in 26 games against Linfield. Linfield head coach **Ed Langsdorf** enters his second season with a 12-1 record. He is 2-0 against PLU.

ABOUT PLU: The Lutes return 34 lettermen from last year, including eight offensive starters and five defensive starters. Record-setting senior quarterback **Marc Weekly**, the 1992 Mt. Rainier League Offensive Player of the Year, will lead the Lute offense. The backfield boasts a dynamic duo in **Chad Barnett** and **Aaron Tang**, a pair of speedsters who combined for more than 3,100 all-purpose yards last season. The offensive line is solid with returning starters **Kurtis Bonar**, **Jeff Douglass**, **Brian Flattum** and **Aaron Linnerud**. A key to the Lutes' success in 1993 will be their ability to reload the defense, where six starters were lost to graduation, including the entire secondary. The defensive nucleus this year consists of returning linebackers **Judd Benedick**, **Ted Riddall** and **Jon Rubey**, the team's leading tackler in 1992. **Jason Thiel** and **Albert Jackson** are mainstays on the line.

ABOUT LINFIELD: The Wildcats, national runners-up in 1992, enter the 1993 season with high hopes of a second-straight NAIA Division II championship game appearance. The optimism is well-founded, with 39 lettermen and 14 starters returning from last year. Linebackers **Darrin Causey** and **Julian Tyrell** lead the Linfield defense, while the offense should benefit from the experience of returning starters **Matt Golda**, **Curt Scholl** and **Jeff Wallace**. Coach Langsdorf will have to find a replacement at quarterback for graduated **Shannon Sells**, who was the 1992 Mt. Hood League Offensive Player of the Year.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE DOME: Pacific Lutheran has compiled a 7-4-1 record in 12 Tacoma Dome appearances. In the only previous "Dome" meeting between PLU and Linfield, the Lutes pulled off a 9-8 victory in the 1991 season opener for both squads.
