

Finger Lakes Regional Hockey Association Emergency Protocol

All Coaches will have emergency contact information for all players and coaches, which will include.

- : Player name**
- : Parents name**
- : Player's doctor, name and phone #.**
- : Any medical conditions and allergies**
- : Hospital phone #**
- : Emergency contact phone # (incase parent cant be reached)**

There will be a folder in locker in The Rink nearest the home bench for each team that will include all this information per child and coach.

All coaches will have their own folder for away games with all the same information.

The locker will also include a extra First Aid Kit along with one that each coach will have on the bench at each practice and home and away games.

All teams MUST have at bench at all times, First Aid kit, approved by board along with spare water bottles.

If player is injured the Head Coach will be in charge of administrating First Aid. Assistant Coaches will continue coaching practice and games until Head Coach returns.

Each team will have a parent administrator to help Coach with making emergency calls if needed, corresponding with parents and assistant coaches on condition of player.

Team Manager will also have emergency contact information for all players and coaches and when traveling have nearest hospital contact information ready incase of emergency.

Any emergency that has to be treated by physician must be documented and signed by coach and submitted to Finger Lakes Regional Hockey Association Board of Directors.
