

First, go to this link, click on the “2017-2018 Coaches Registration” and get registered with Mankato Hockey as well as USA Hockey, **this need to be done first and has to be completed before you step on the ice for your first practice.**

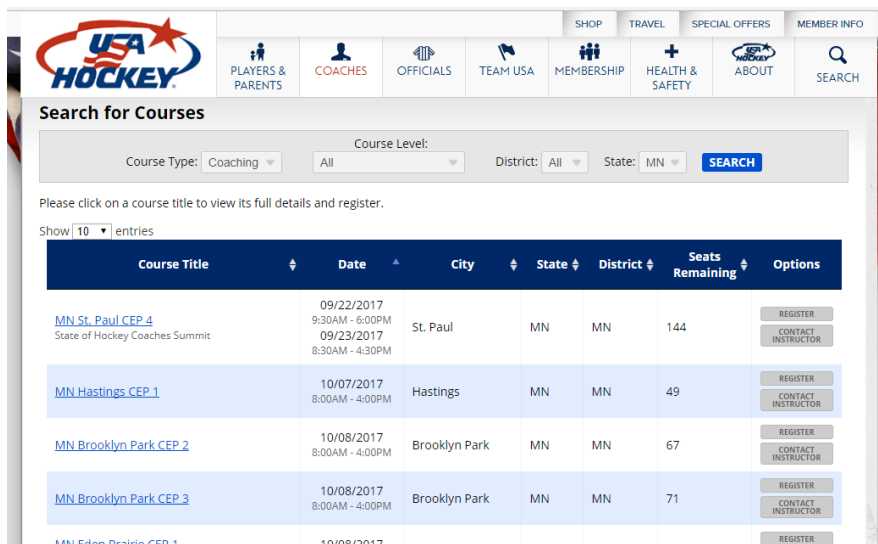

Third, All coaches need to take an online concussion training, here is the link. **This must be completed before your team's first practice.**

Fourth, All coaches need to complete the Safe Sport online training, the training is provided in conjunction with the U.S. Olympic Committee so you will need to register separately for this training by creating a Team USA Account with the USOC here <https://training.teamusa.org/accounts/signin> **This must be completed before your team's first practice.**

Make sure to forward your email receipt to Margot Hansen - MAHA Registrar (Margot Hansen – MAHA Registrar registrar@mankatohockey.com and Adam Arnoldy - MAHA Treasurer treasurer@mankatohockey.com and they will get you your reimbursement check.

All certifications, modules, and trainings must be completed by December 31st 2017, if coaches do not complete all requirements coaches will be removed from the team's roster and unable to coach the rest of the season.
