Football

The Titans defeated St. Patrick 34-21 at home on Friday, September 1 to move to 2-0 on the season.

"This is such an important win for our program right now," quarterback Jeffrey Chrones told the Glenview Lantern. "To turn this thing around and really get a good start to the season. We're all excited where this team can be going."

The titans had a balanced offense, stout defense and key plays on special teams. Senior Anthony Savino took the opening kickoff deep into St. Patrick territory and the offense rolled from there.

On the night, Senior fullback Jalen Covington (15 carries, 112 yards, one touchdown) , sophomore halfback Andrew Gall (20 carries, 88 yards, two touchdowns) and senior wingback Ben Hides (six carries, 32 yards) dominated the rushing game. The Titans ran for ran for three touchdowns and 230 yards on 46 carries, averaging 5.0 yards per carry.

Chrones was 9-of-13 for 134 passing yards and two touchdowns.



### **Girls Golf**

The Girls Golf team began their season at the Barrington Invite. They placed 6th out of 11 teams with Maria Perakis taking 6th place individually. The team then played at the Prospect Invite, coming in 5th place as a team. Hanna Tanaka took home a 4th place medal, while Maria Perakis placed 8th individually.

The team then played a tri-match against Deerfield and Hersey and defeated both teams, with Hanna Tanaka taking home medalist honors. From there the team played another tri against GBN and Fremd, and was able to again defeat both teams, with Maria Perakis and Sophia Lau tying for medalist. An 18-hole dual against HP resulted in another victory, with Hanna Tanaka again earning medalist honors.

The busy second week was capped off with the 12-team Hersey Invite, where the Titans captured first place! Maria Perakis (3rd place), Hanna Tanaka (4th place) and Sophia Lau (6th place) all received individual medals.

### **Boys Golf**

The Glenbrook South boys' golf team met Niles North at The Glenview Park Golf Course on Wednesday, August, 30. Both the Varsity and Frosh/Soph teams were victorious. The Frosh/Soph team won 167-237. The Varsity score was GBS 149 to NN 204. Scoring for Titans were Brian O'Connor with a one over par 36, Jack Grier with a two over par 37 and Chris Leftakes and Jarrett Prchal both in with a three over par 38. This puts the boys' team at 2-0 in conference play with a 1-0 south division record.

The next CSL action is next week when the Titans face Maine South on Tuesday Sept 5 and Niles West on Thursday Sept 7.

The Varsity Boys Soccer team went 4 - 0 over the week to be named champions of the 32nd Annual Jim Wolter Titan Invitational. The Titans opened on Tuesday by defeating Mundelein 3-2. Scoring for the Titans were Tony Hernandez (assisted by Henry Huynh), Jimmy McMahon (assisted by Gavin Morse), and Jeremy Weber (assisted by Michael Hatfield).

The Titans then defeated Rolling Meadows with a final score of 1-0. Scoring the lone game-winning goal for the Titans was Eric Hyun, assisted by Jimmy McMahon.

The Titans concluded round-robin play by defeating Guerin Prep with a final score of 7-0. Scoring for the Titans were Jimmy McMahon (2 goals), Matthew Ruth, Lucas Balbinot, Dar Shegarfi, David Joseph and Joshua Shin. Matthew Ruth and Adam White each had 2 assists while Henry Huynh, Jeremy Weber, and Jonathan Hernandez each assisted 1 goal.

In the championship match the Titans came back from a 0-1 deficit to defeat the Wheeling Wildcats with a final score of 3-2. Scoring for Titans were Jimmy McMahon with 2 goals and Jeremy Weber with the game-winner. The goals were assisted by Jonathan Hernandez and David Joseph. Goalkeeper Michael Hatfield made 4 saves to help preserve the win.

It has been 8 years since GBS has been in the championship game and 13 years since the last time they have won as champions of the Titan Invitational. Excellent job on the team accomplishment!

The Titans will continue the season next week with games against Maine West, Highland Park, and an overnight tournament in Morton, Illinois.
