Notes:

¹USA Hockey Fee is an annual fee for youth ages 7 and up. A single USA Hockey registration is required per year regardless of number of programs enrolled in. For example, if player is enrolled in Mites and Hockey 3 & 4, only one USA Hockey registration fee is paid.

²All skaters at U10-U14 levels (Girls / Squirts-Bantam) will also be charged a non-refundable fee of \$20 for use of team jersey(s).

³BDHA has a mandatory ticket purchase for the Skaters Unlimited Banquet (fundraising). One ticket per family (U8-U14 / Mites-Bantam) will be purchased at registration. The ticket price is added to overall fees and collected during registration. Additional tickets purchased will earn \$20 in fundraising credits per ticket.

⁴**50% of all Base Fees is due upon registration, and the remaining balance is due on December 1st.**

⁵Skaters in Hockey 1 & 2, Hockey 3 & 4, Girls Developmental, and Atoms programs are exempt from fundraising credits.

⁶Each family will be required to sell \$100 worth of "raffle" tickets during the season.

⁷Work and fundraising credits can be paid off at registration or deferred to be earned during the season.

How are Work & Fundraising Credits Earned?.....

(1) WORK CREDITS can be earned by volunteering to serve in the following ways (these are examples, there are other opportunities):
 (Note: credits range from \$5, \$10, and \$15 per hour depending level of work or responsibility):

(2) FUNDRAISING CREDITS can be earned in multiple ways. Other fundraising opportunities will be available.

5) Lambeau Concessions	August-January	6 hours work credits per event

“DISCOUNTS” for Multiple Players

Reduced Fees:

I. Families with 2 children in the program will receive:

- (a) A 50% discount on the Program Base Fee, Work Credits, and Fundraising Credits for the youngest child (or 2nd child) who would be in Mites-Bantams. This does not apply to any child in Hockey 1 & 2, Hockey 3 & 4, Girls Developmental, or Atoms.
- (b) A 50% discount on the Base Fee for the older (1st child) only if he/she is a new, first-time player at Squirts-Bantams.

II. Families with 3 or more children in the program will receive:

- (a) A 50% discount on the Base Fee and a full waiver of Work and Fundraising Credit requirements for the youngest child that would be in Mites-Bantams. This does not apply to any child in Hockey 1 & 2, Hockey 3 & 4, Girls Developmental, or Atoms.
- (b) A 50% discount on the Base Fee for the other, or older, children if they are new, first-time players in U10-U14 levels (Girls / Squirts-Bantams).

III. In all cases for families with multiple players, the 50% Base Fee reduction for “new, first-time” players would apply only to those in U10-U14 levels (Girls / Squirts-Bantams) who did not already receive the family discount.
