

Dear Post 15 Families~

SEBA affords multiple opportunities for families pay for baseball. In addition to the SCRIP program, SEBA has teamed up with the Denny Sanford Premier Center to allow families to work concession during events happening at the Premier Center, the Arena Convention Center and the Canaries ballfield.

How it works is you let me know if you are interested in working concessions at these venues. I will send out a Signup Genius link with the event, date, time and location once an event has been secured. If you are able to work and spots are still open, sign up through the link.

Those signing up are responsible for running that concession stand along with the help of a Premier Center Concessions manager. Shifts are typically 4 to 6 hours. Anyone 15 years and older may work and we must have at minimum one adult per shift.

Everyone must wear SEBA attire, including parents along with long black pants and closed toed shoes (sweatpants are fine-NO shorts/sandals/flipflops). If you wear a hat, it must be Post 15. Long hair must be tied back.

Pay is \$55.00 per shift unless otherwise noted. There is consideration for tips and percentage of sales in addition to the shift wage. Once payment is received from the Premier Center, I will apply it to the account of those who worked the shift. Funds may be used to offset expenses for the upcoming season, camps or academy. There is no cashout option.

Please make sure you are truly available for the event you sign up for. We realize life events happen, but we can't have people sign up and not show up. The Premier Center counts on us and there is a lot of competition among organizations to secure concession opportunities. To date, SEBA has a very good reputation with the Premier Center. We'd like to keep it that way.
