OT2 SNOWBOARD TEAM

Our snowboarding program offers a variety of learning formats for entry-level to advanced riders age 8 to 18. Offered on six or nine consecutive **Saturdays**. From never-ers to switch-riding, bumps, jumps, carving, rails and "just want to throw down tricks in the terrain park." Trainers and coaches attend weekly clinics from AASI certified clinicians to keep up their game.

OTTO MASTERY TEAMS

In each Mastery Program, the season culminates with an assessment, and qualified athletes are invited to participate in the Otto Hollaus Cup Race at season's end.

MINI MASTERS TEAM

9 Saturdays or 9 Sundays - \$524, transportation included.
Open to skiers age 10 and 11 by invitation.

The Mini Masters program allows this group to explore different turn shapes, sizes and there application in the race course, park and pipe, and terrain variations.

JUNIOR MASTERS TEAM

9 Saturdays or 9 Sundays - \$524, transportation included.
Open to skiers age 12 and 13 by invitation.

The Junior Masters program offers challenging activities, whether it's hitting the park or mastering all-mountain skills. In addition to running gates, techniques that begin to develop high end skiing are introduced and applied to various terrain.

MASTERS TEAM

9 Saturdays or 9 Sundays - \$524, transportation included.
Open to skiers age 14 to 18 by invitation.

Masters students train closely with coaches to achieve peak performance on the race course, steeps, bumps, groomed, or in the terrain park. Students learn the mechanics and a deeper understanding of skill blending required for both all-mountain enjoyment and competitive ski racing.

MASTERS PERFORMANCE TEAM

9 Saturdays - \$524, transportation included.
Open to skiers age 14 to 18 by invitation.

Masters Performance participants are intrinsically motivated and excel at personal goal achievement. Performance athletes improve their ability through exploration of all terrain and conditions; bumps, steeps, gates and park & pipe. The program culminates with a season-end self assessment.

MASTERS ELITE TEAM

9 Saturdays - \$524, transportation included.
Open to skiers age 15 to 18 with one or more years MASTERS participation & 80+ score on the MASTERS test.

With personalized coaching, shared peak performance is the goal. Confident in their abilities in gates, steep, park and pipe, team demonstrations, or even lunch, each experience is about the joy and achievement the sport can bring.

TERRAIN MASTERS TEAM

9 Saturdays - \$524, transportation included.
Open to skiers who have successfully passed the MINI MASTERS test** (Class Limit is 8 Athletes).

Terrain Masters is designed to give athletes introductory progressions of **freestyle skiing**. Focused specifically on techniques, tricks, etiquette, and safety, students will learn how to become comfortable in the terrain park, and will experience various features to master.

The goal of Race Master's is to challenge alpine ski racer's to further their potential. Curriculum will utilize the United States Ski Team Alpine Training System, weekly video analysis and individualized coaching. Athletes will recognize that solid fundamentals, practiced free skiing are the key to instinctive, fast gate skiing.

JUNIOR INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT TEAM

9 Saturdays - \$459, without transportation,

Open to skiers/riders age 15 to 18 interested in teaching.

Skiing skills, instructional manuals, handouts, and a wealth of practical knowledge provide a foundation for development as a ski instructor. All participants are given a year-end, on-snow and written assessment. Those achieving the goals set by the assessment are invited to the staff the following season.
