OK USA WRESTLING TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

1. Tournament Set Up:
 - a. Mats need to be numbered 1 - ?
 - b. All Tables must be numbered consistently with mat number.
 - c. Table workers need to be in venue by 8:15 am for in service (trackwrestling) at 8:30 am.
 - d. All table workers need to be ready at designated mat by 9:15 am.
 - e. Athletic Trainer location needs to be designated
 - f. Locate security. Advise of responsibility for the tournament.
 - g. All mats need to be mopped prior to competition.
2. Tournament Times and Info:
 - a. The day before the tournament at 3:00 PM online registration will close
 - b. Thursday 6:00 pm tournament director will receive 4 documents by email
 - i. Team list – list of wrestlers by team and div and weight
 - ii. Weigh in sheets – list of wrestlers by div and weight
 - iii. Add on – document to add any walk up registrations from Friday night weigh in.
 - iv. Coaches sign in sheet
 - c. Saturday on site weigh in time – 7:00 am – 7:30 am – NO WALK UPREGISTRATIONS
 - d. Saturday coaches check-in – 8:00 am – 8:30 am – USA coaches card needs to be present to receive coach's band. No exceptions – All coaches will sign in on designated sign in sheet.
 - e. Saturday technique clinic 8:30 am – 9:00 am – Each tournament director will provide a 30min technician – technique needs to be logged
 - f. Saturday warm up for wrestlers – 9:00 am – 9:30 am
 - g. Saturday coaches meeting @ 9:00 am
 - h. Saturday wrestling begins @ 9:30 am
3. Coaches:
 - a. Must have valid USA Wrestling Coaches Card
 - b. All Coaches must check in at designated table to receive coaches band for the tournament
 - i. Tournament director may sell floor bands (Alternate Color) 15.00 (Minimum)
 - ii. 2 Coaches per corner – Each coach must have visible wrist band
 - iii. Coaches will be provided triangular area on each of mat and / or chairs for 2 banded coaches only.
4. Admission:
 - a. All USA Coaches Card Members – Will show card at admission table – Free
 - b. Adults 12 year of age – older (6.00)
 - c. 12 year of age and below – Free
 - d. Stamps must be available
 - e. Tournament Director discretion as to when to stop admission table
5. Hospitality Room:
 - a. All tournaments must provide hospitality room
 - b. Available to – Referees, Coaches and Volunteers – Tournament directors discretion

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES CONT.

 - c. Water will need to be delivered to referees every hour of tournament
6. Referees:
 - a. **Head gear is mandatory**

- b. *Hair Rule will not be enforced*
 - c. *Mouth Piece required to cover designated brace*
 - d. Referees Locker room or designated locked location provided.
 - e. All Referee payments will be paid in small bills – Cash
 - f. Head Referee will make all final decision regarding all challenges
7. Security:
- a. All tournaments will be required to have at least 1 security officer or designee available.
 - b. Payment will be at Tournament directors' discretion.
8. Parent and Coaches Conduct Policy:
- a. Each tournament director will follow Parent / Coach Conduct policy for any event that is warranted to be reported.
9. Tournament Sessions:
- a. Will be determined by tournament director
 - b. All timed sessions will be stated on the tournament flier
10. Weight Classes and Divisions: **Age cut off for each Division in Sept 1**

22. Wrestling:
- a. All Novice Matches – Championship and Consolation will be (1,1,1)
 - b. Division 1 Open – Championship (1,1,1) / Consolation (1,1,1)
 - c. Division 2 – 5 Open – Championship (1 ½, 1 ½, 1 ½) / Consolation (1,1,1)
 - d. All match procedures
 - i. Mat Volunteers will band all wrestlers on deck
 - ii. Mat Volunteers will have all wrestlers double check after match to verify winner
 - iii. Coaches will be responsible for wrestlers verification at the end of match
23. Awards:
- a. Medals will be provided for place winners 1st – 4th. It is tournament directors discretion for (5th and 6th)
 - b. All tournament directors will provide a designated awards area. Podium and additional awards will be tournament director's discretion.

WEIGH IN PROCEDURE

1. All Tournament Registration will be on Trackwrestling
 - a. Registration deadline is Wednesday of tournament week at 10:00 pm
2. All Satellite weigh in sites will open at 6:00 pm and stay open through 6:30 pm
 - a. Weigh in Master Discretion to weigh any wrestler after 6:30 pm.
3. All Weigh In sites will have 1 or more registration tables
 - a. All wrestlers will check in at registration table first.
 - i. Wrestlers will need to have current USA Wrestling Card available
 - b. Registration Volunteers will have a team list by team, name, division and weight
 - i. Registration volunteer will mark off wrestler with yellow highlighter
 - ii. Wrestler will receive (1) carnival ticket – this is their weigh in ticket
 - iii. Wrestler will proceed to designated weigh in table
4. ANY active and sanctioned OKUSA YWL Club May apply and be awarded a Remote Satellite Weigh In location, under the condition that there is no other Remote Satellite Weigh In location within a 20 mile radius of their requested site.
5. 1. Weigh in site tables need to designated with signage
 - i. Weigh in Volunteers will have Weigh in sheets by Division, Weigh, Name and Team
 - ii. **All Wrestlers Must Weigh In in Singlet it is mandatory**
1. Weigh in Volunteers will weigh the wrestler. Mark off wrestlers that made weight on weigh in sheet with a yellow highlighter.
2. Weigh in Volunteer will mark wrestlers that do not make weight in pink highlighter and write in box provided the wrestlers new weight class.
3. Weigh in Volunteers will take weigh in tickets and keep them for tournament director.
4. **Weigh in Master should yellow card any wrestler at weigh in that a skin condition. Those wrestlers should be added to Add on Doc.**
5. **Trainers on Saturday morning will receive list of questioned wrestlers to clear.**
 - b. Late Registration:
 - i. Any wrestler that shows up to the registration table that is not registered online trackwrestling and is not on team registration list
 - ii. Tournament director will have 1 additional table marked late registration table.
 1. Wrestler will go the late registration table
 - a. Wrestler will show a current USA Wrestling Card
 - b. Late registration fee will be \$30.00
 - c. Late Registration Volunteer will take Weigh card (provided by OK USA Wrestling) add name and club of the wrestler registering late.
 - d. Wrestler will take the weigh in card to designated weigh in table.
 - e. Weigh in Volunteer will add weight and division
 - i. Weigh card will be collected by tournament directors to add to late add on doc.
 - d. Tournament Director will have a Friday 6:00 pm – 6:30 pm and a Saturday 7:00 am – 7:30 am Weigh in for wrestlers.
1. NO LATE REGISTRATION ON SATURDAY!!!!
 - e. All Weigh in Masters will send Weigh in Sheet and Add on Doc back to Tournament Directors by 8:00 pm on Friday. Via emailed DOC or scanned back to tournament director.

OK USA WRESTLING REGISTRATION PROCESS

- A. **Wednesday of tournament week all registrations will need to be done on trackwrestling.com by 10:00 pm.**

A trackwrestling link will be provided on the tournament flier and electronically on OK USA Wrestling website on youth schedule tab.

1. Any changes must be made by Friday at 7:00 pm to ensure that Tournament Director is capable of making necessary adjustments needed.
2. All wrestler competing in an OK USA Youth Wrestling League tournament must have a current USA Wrestling Competitor card.
 - a. Each wrestler will need to either have a hard copy of current USA Wrestling competitor card or...
 - b. Each wrestler can have a picture on a mobile device to show at registration instead of hard copy.
 - i. Recommendation: Have multiple copies on phones and hard copies available in case of need for a backup.
3. Club coordinators have your coaches and parents look on the trackwrestling tournament site registration and brackets to ensure that there are no mistakes prior to Approx. 9:00 am on tournament date so issues can be solved quickly.
4. Club Coordinators please spend some time with your parents, wrestlers, and members on how to:
 - a. Log in to trackwrestling
 - b. How to enter tournament
 - c. How to browse the tournament features
 - d. How to read brackets and bout numbers
5. Any questions about trackwrestling and / or registration please refer to list of trackwrestling managers under the youth tab of OK USA Wrestling website.

REFEREE PAYMENT POLICY

1. All 1 day tournaments are \$200.00 per referee prior to 5:30 pm
After 5:30 pm each hour will be at a rate of \$30.00 per hour per referee
2. All 2 day tournaments will be \$300.00 per referee prior to 5:30 pm
After 5:30 pm each hour will be at a rate of \$30.00 per hour per referee
3. \$50.00 Additional to head referee – designated prior to tournament - tournament director notified
4. Any referee traveling over 50 miles one way will receive \$.25 per mile over the 50 miles up to 125 miles limit.
5. This payment scale will be on a 4 referee to 3 mat ratio
6. All Referees will follow conduct and etiquette policy provided by OK USA Wrestling
7. All tournament directors will call head referee by 9:00 pm on Thursday prior to tournament to add or delete number of referees.
8. All payments to referees will be given to head referee at conclusion of tournament for disbursement to the referee crew. All payments will be in cash. Head referee will sign received receipt.

Oklahoma USA Wrestling Coaches/Parent Code of Conduct and Corrective Action Policy

Our mission statement is, "Building a program that creates an opportunity at every level and promotes the sport of wrestling in the state of Oklahoma" This is true at many levels including our state organization coaches. It is imperative that our organization demonstrates to each coach that we are providing a positive atmosphere of training and support for them and for the organization. Parents and Coaches who do not follow the Oklahoma USA ("OK USA") Wrestling Code of Conduct will be subject to this Corrective Action Policy.

OK USA reserves the right to take whatever measure it believes appropriate under the circumstances. When circumstances arise where the action(s) of a parent or coach warrant a complaint, said complaint must be addressed. The raised complaint will be documented by the event coordinator/OK USA Representative. This will initiate corrective action(s) toward the parent or coach in question. In determining an appropriate sanction, OK USA will consider the severity of the conduct and the frequency of similar or other violations of conduct by the parent or coach.

Action: OK USA Representative/Event Director shall submit, within three days of complaint, a written statement describing said incident.

Response: An email shall be written to the parent or coach with whom the reported complaint is being raised. A three day response period will be in effect for a rebutted written statement.

Once both statements have been received, a copy will be sent to the OK USA Executive Board for review. Pursuant to the Corrective Action Guidelines below, one or more of the following corrective actions shall be applied following review by the Executive Board.

Step 1 – Verbal Warning. An OK USA Representative will discuss undesirable conduct with the parent or coach and stress that this behavior will not be tolerated. This will be documented and kept on file.

Step 2 – Written warning and apology to the OK USA Organization. An OK USA Representative will meet with the parent or coach to discuss action(s). Additionally, there will be a formal letter of reprimand given to the parent or coach stating that the next offense could lead to the parent or coach being banned from tournaments for a period of one or more months. Coaches will have to complete a copper level certification.

Step 3 – One - Three month suspension of attendance of events and/or practices. An OK USA Representative will ban the parent or coach from attending the next scheduled events for one – three months, depending on the severity of action(s). Another letter will be given to the parent or coach stating that the next offense will lead to the parent or coach being banned for one year. The coach will be required to complete a bronze certification.

Step 4 – One Year Suspension of attendance of events and/or practices. The parent or coach will be banned from attending events for one year. The parent or coach must make a formal written request to be re-instated into the organization.

Step 5 – Life-time ban from OK USA organization events and practices.

After corrective action(s) have been issued, any violation of the corrective action will advance the corrective action. Violation of the policy will result in corrective action up to and including the possible immediate suspension of a parent and/or coach by Oklahoma USA Wrestling. 3X Violator will advance directly to Step 5 - LIFE TIME ban status. This policy is in place to protect the kids, clubs and the organization.

Membership Process for Athletes:

Option 1 – Individual

1. Go to www.usawmembership.com.
2. Sign in if you have been a member and click “Purchase Membership” in upper left-hand corner of page and select which type of membership you desire.
3. If you have never been a member, you will first set up a profile and then proceed with membership purchase.
4. Payment can be made by debit or credit card.
5. Membership card can be printed once payment is made.

Option 2 – Group

1. Attached you will find an Oklahoma Club Registration form (titled *Oklahoma Club Registration.xls*).
2. Fill out the form completely - one line for each club member (wrestlers only)
3. Please fill out all information for each wrestler. Phone and e-mail address should be for parent/guardian of member.

Membership Process for Coaches

1. Go to www.usawmembership.com.
2. Sign in if you have been a member and click “Purchase Membership” in upper left-hand corner of page and select which type of membership you desire.
3. If you have never been a member, you will first set up a profile and then proceed with selection of coach membership.
4. If you have a valid background screening, you select the coach membership and proceed with membership purchase.
5. For those in need of a background screening, you will be directed to TC LogiQ’s website to perform your background screening. The cost of the screening is \$15 and approved screenings are valid for two (2) membership seasons.
6. Once your background screening is approved, you are notified by e-mail. Please go to www.usawmembership.com and complete steps 1-4 from above.

Match Protest

When a match outcome is going to protest this procedure is to be followed:

1. A match protest procedure (OK USA YWL) should be made by the coach of the wrestler that is protesting.
2. The wrestler that is protesting must remain on the mat that the match being protested was wrestled on.
 - a. Coach must notify match referee that a call is being protested and the head referee needs to be notified immediately.
 - i. If wrestler leaves the mat before the match referee is notified then there is not a valid protest available.
3. Once head referee reaches mat side he will then allow protesting wrestlers coach to articulate protest.

A protest may be accepted and examined when:

- There has been a flagrant violation of the rules.
- There has been a timing error, during which the score of the bout changed.
- Two wrestlers have arrived at a prior agreement regarding the outcome of their bout, to influence the classification of an opponent.
- The judge and referee have awarded points in a unanimous manner and the mat chairman has changed their decision.
- Points are entered in inverse order on the judge's and mat chairman's score sheets, by error, or
- Points have been awarded by majority vote of the officiating team and, by error, these points have not been entered on the score sheets.

A protest may not be accepted nor examined when:

- It concerns the officials' judgment.
- It concerns disqualification of one or both wrestlers for cautions, brutality or violation of the rule.
- It concerns a period in which a fall has been called and confirmed, unless the period/match should have been ended prior to the fall occurring (ie.: technical superiority previously occurred).
- The outcome of the protest will not change the winner of the period or match.

4. After head referee hears protest from wrestlers coach. Head referee and match referee will address the protest. If applicable according to above provisions.
5. Head referee will then make a decision. Decision will be final. No Appeals.

NOVICE DIVISION POLICIES AND RULES:

OK USA YWL will host a Novice Division during the Folkstyle Season

Novice: Defined - a person new to or inexperienced in a field or situation

*** An OK USA YWL Novice wrestler will be defined as a **NEW** wrestler or that is **INEXPERIENCED**. If a wrestler wrestles open before medal count is met they will not be allowed back in the novice division.

OK USA YWL Policy to move from Novice to Open:

Each Novice Wrestler will move into open upon completion of awarded medals

D1	4 medals
D2	6 medals
D3	8 medals
D4 and Div 5	10 medals

- 1) It counts as a medal won if the bracket has 6 or more wrestlers.
- 2) If a Novice Wrestler wins Novice State they must move to Open Division.
- 3) If a Novice Wrestler places in an Open Tournament in a bracket with 6 or more wrestlers before their medal count is met they will not be allowed back in the Novice Division.

Trackwrestling will be used to track placements and notification will be sent to club coach.

Additionally, any wrestler will be eligible for competition at the State Championship in the Novice division if the individual begins the season as a qualified Novice. Athletes who excel quickly and 'move up' to the open division will remain eligible to compete and can expect to be rewarded for their advancements.

With this in mind, the current graduated medal count has the intention of keeping the Novice division as a spring board for advancement. It will above all safeguard inexperienced wrestlers from negative first experiences, and promote an environment in which basic skills can be rewarded. We wish for the Novice division to be a launch pad, not a destination.

Because the approach outlined will create a faster migration to the open level, advancing wrestlers will also find a 'smoother' transition to open tournaments. Top advancing Novices will be continually challenged by greater competition while at the same time competing with other advancing Novices.

Please keep in mind, the target is moving and there is no perfect scenario for entry into 'The toughest Sport on Earth.' In the beginning, USAOK's Youth Wrestling League (YWL) will rely heavily on the integrity of our coaches and parents to help us build the best possible experience for our youth wrestlers in the Novice division. We will dutifully track medals to the best of our ability with your help and put in place technology as quickly as possible. Keep in touch with any directors, coaches and members about your concerns and ideas.

- 1) All points will begin accumulation September 1st and end August 31st.
- 2) If we have multiple wrestlers at the same weight with same points the oldest wrestler will get preference.
- 3) If we have multiple wrestlers at the same weight, same points, and age then whoever placed higher at OK USA State will get top placement.
- 4) USJOC and Tulsa Nationals will be put under consideration.
- 5) Points will be accumulated for USA Wrestling Tournaments ONLY.
- 6) *It is each parent's responsibility to turn in all your wrestlers Regional and National placement information to stevenwschmidt@gmail.com and to confirm that your points are correct.

Complaint Procedure

In any instance that a complaint is warranted then here is the steps to file that said complaint:

1. Only a coach or director of an OK USA YWL Chartered club can file a complaint.
2. A written complaint must be filed within 48 hrs. of stated event. That written complaint shall be emailed to OK USA YWL Youth Chairman in that time frame. If complaint is not received in the 48 hr. time frame then complaint will not be addressed.
3. After a review by the chairman. The chairman will send a report and a recommendation to the OK USA YWL board for review. If accepted by majority vote then recommendation stands with no grounds of an appeal.
4. If the OK USA YWL Board does not receive a majority vote of the recommendation then the complaint, vote count and recommendation then it will be reviewed by the OK USA executive board. This vote and solution will be final. A written response shall be sent to complainant within 48 hrs. of complaint received with notification or decision.
5. This policy is not to be mistaken with match protest.

Inclement Weather Policy

1. Tournament cancellations decision will be a sole decision of tournament director.
 - a. If tournament is cancelled all entry responsibility will be relinquished
