



**Boys and Girl's 3rd-4th Grade Divisions**  
No dunking or hanging on rims!



- 1) (4) 8 Minute quarters, clock only stops last minute of the 4th quarter and at time-outs.
- 2) (1) Minute between quarters and (3) minute halftime.
- 3) Every player must play at least (8) minutes each half.
- 4) (2) Time-outs per half. Time-outs will be 1 minute.
- 5) (5) Seconds in lane.
- 6) (5) Fouls per game.
- 7) This division uses the 9' goal and a 27.5 inch ball.
- 8) (1+1) Free throws on the 7th team foul (2) after 10th team foul.
- 9) First technical foul player sits (16) minutes, 2nd technical foul is ejection plus one game suspension, 3rd technical foul is suspended for season.
- 10) Coaches must rotate starting players each game.
- 11) Allow all players to bring the ball down the court, and play point guard.
- 12) Intentional foul is (2) free throws and ball out of bounds.
- 13) If game is tied after regulation, one (3) min. overtime period will be played with each team receiving (1) additional timeout. If the score is tied after overtime period, the game will be declared a tie.
- 14) 1st half, NO full court pressing or trapping allowed. Fast breaks are defensible.
- 15) In the 1st half, teams may NOT pressure the ball until it has reached the volleyball line above the three point line. 2nd half teams may pressure at 1/2 court, unless ahead by 10 points or more. Last (4th) quarter teams may pressure full court, unless ahead by 10 points or more.
- 16) **Teams may play zone defense one quarter each half. (Cannot split time, one quarter only)**
- 17) Coaches and players will police their own team trash, and or spills, after each game.
- 18) Participates from both teams of the last game of the day will help with gym cleanup. Coaches will count basketballs and sign off on the clipboard that none are missing. Balls are not to be removed from their assigned gym.
- 19) The coach is allowed one assistant on the bench during games.
- 20) Protest of games calls or situations are not allowed; the referee's calls and decisions are final.
- 21) One coach allowed on court, but cannot impede with play. Coach must stay in the coaches box; they are not allowed to walk onto the other half of

the court. Referee will give one warning, next offense will be a technical foul. After the 1st technical foul of a coach, the coach is allowed to stay on the bench. 2nd technical foul, coach is ejected from the current game and receives an additional two game suspension. 3rd technical foul of the season is an automatic suspension from coaching the remainder of the basketball season, and is furthermore suspended from coach for 12 months of any Bulldog Youth Athletic Association sports. Said coach must attend a Board of Director's Meeting at the end of the 12 month suspension to be reinstated by the BYAA Board of Directors.
