Next Year:

If a driver has one skater they will be expected to do four zamboni times as their volunteer hours. If they have two skater's they are expected to do six Zamboni times as their volunteer hours, etc and no other volunteer (concession stand, etc) are needed. Any hours beyond the 4, 6 or 8 will be reimbursed \$8 each. If the driver is a board member (or family of) they will be paid \$8 for all times they drive. Any hours during Ice Show are voluntary – no one gets paid for them.

·50/50 raffle and chuck-a-duck profit will go back into the Ice Show.

- Will remain the same this year.

·Sunday meal concession profit will go toward meals between Ice Show performances and end-of-year banquet.

- Will remain the same this year.

·Wreath sale profit will go towards t-shirts for the Ice Show.

- This year \$5 of the profit from each wreath sold will be put in a fund. The rest of the profit will go towards the t-shirts for the Ice Show. If that fund allows all skaters participating in the Ice Show to receive a \$5 or more credit we will go ahead with the credit. If it is less than \$5 per skater all profits from wreath sales will go towards t-shirts. Skaters are not required to sell wreaths to be eligible for the discount.

·Nutz-Applebee's dine-to-donate profit will go to the high school team.

- Will remain the same this year but includes brat barn and Sunday bake sale profits.

·Apparel profit will go into the general fund because minimal profit is made.

- Will remain the same this year.

·Kwik trip cards, Subway cards and/or Pizza Hut dine-to-donate profit will go towards the Ice Show if a larger item needs to be purchased. Otherwise, it will go towards taking a percentage off of skating costs for all skaters.
