**Chino Hills Girls Softball
Player and Parent/Legal Guardian Conduct Policy**

Welcome to Chino Hills Girls Softball! Our goal as an organization is to provide a safe and fun environment for your daughter while developing their skills and abilities as softball players. The following rules and guidelines – as outlined in CHGS by-laws - are set with each parent/player and are expected to be honored and adhered to:

- Each parent/player will fulfill their part in any league fundraising event or activity.
- This is a volunteer, non-profit organization and as volunteers we need the support of parents for this to run smoothly and successfully. Let's help each other out!
- No position is guaranteed, all is subject to the Manager's discretion and his/her decision on what is best for the overall team, not any individual player, parent or coach.
- Zero tolerance to any vulgarity, abusive or derogatory language towards any adult or minor.
- Detrimental conduct or behavior by any player will be addressed by the Manager and division commissioner. No player shall disrespect any teammate, opposing player, any coach, umpire or parent; always display good sportsmanship. Depending on severity, the Manager may contact the Board for assistance.
- Detrimental conduct or behavior from any parent will be addressed by the Manager and division commissioner. Derogatory remarks about players, playing time, coaching abilities, other parents, etc., will not be ignored. It may result in the parent being barred from games or the player being suspended or removed from the team. The Manager cannot tolerate any undermining of the team by any parent.
- Coaching from the stands is not encouraged as it causes player confusion and poor play.
- Each player/parent will make every attempt to arrive on time for practices and games, unless excused by the Manager. Player must be properly dressed and ready to begin at the start time (cleats on, shirt tucked, hair pulled up, etc.).
- Player must have water/Gatorade during practices and games and must have good nutrition prior to any event, between games, as well as throughout the season. It is your responsibility to get nutrition during your time, not warm-up or game time (unless in back-to-back game situations).
- No food, candy or soda permitted in the dugout at any time, unless Manager approves. Don't leave dugout, notify a coach if you are going to the restroom. Parents are to stay out of the dugout unless providing nutrition to the players.
- All electronic devices must remain in player's bag during practices and games.
- Attend as many practices and games as possible, with the understanding that family, education and church come first (notify Manager if you'll be late or absent). Respect the priorities of other players and parents.
- Communication with the Manager is a key part of a successful and enjoying season. Please do not confront or question any member of the coaching staff during or immediately after a game. Allow a minimum of 24 hours to pass before contacting or meeting with the Manager to discuss any issue on your mind. A Parent Representative may also be available if you do not want to contact the Manager.
- Alcohol consumption is prohibited at any CHGS and USA Softball sanctioned event with the exception at BLD. Alcohol consumption at BLD must be done inside the bar area or up the stairs away from the field, dugout and bleachers. Managers, coaches, team parents, or any adult helping with the team shall not consume alcohol, prior, during, or in between games. Anyone not in compliance will immediately be suspended from any team activity. Any member of the league which includes parents and family members, caught in violation of this rule, will be suspended from attending the following game as well.
