Umpire Game Fees, Umpire Membership Reimbursement, & Umpire Attire Policy 2024

Effective from 2023 the NDBA UDP has increased the Umpire Game Fees payment schedule to the following

If in the case of an Umpire No-Show and one Umpire handles both Plate & Bases, payment will be 100% of the Plate rate and 50% of Bases rate

We will be paying Umpires by e-transfer on an every 2 weeks basis. These e-transfers will be made within 5 business days of every 2 weeks end. Please make sure your current information is on file with the NDBA UDP Umpire-In-Chief (Graeme McMurray).

In order to Umpire for the NDBA UDP you must complete the BCBUA requirements

Level 1	\$35.00 (under 13) \$65.00 (over 13) BCBUA membership fee/clinic fee
Level 2	\$35.00 (under 13) \$65.00 (over 13) BCBUA membership fee/clinic fee
Level 3	\$65.00 BCBUA membership fee, \$100.00 BCBUA clinic fee for a total of \$165.00
Level 4/5	\$65.00 BCBUA membership fee, \$175.00 BCBUA clinic fee, \$75.00 National membership fee and \$50.00 BCBUA travel fund fee for a total of \$365.00

The NDBA UDP will reimburse Umpires of our association based on the following schedule

Level 1	\$35.00 or \$65.00 – will be reimbursed in full at the conclusion of the NDBA UDP Summer Season (August) as long as the Umpire works five (5) official NDBA UDP games.
Level 2	\$35.00 or \$65.00 – will be reimbursed in full at the conclusion of the NDBA UDP Summer Season (August) as long as the Umpire works five (5) official NDBA UDP games.
Level 3	\$165.00 - The NDBA UDP will reimburse 100% of the Level 3, \$100.00 BCBUA clinic fee and \$65.00 BCBUA membership fee if the Umpire works ten (10) official NDBA UDP games for a total of \$165.00 (receipts will be required) which will be paid out at the conclusion of the NDBA UDP Summer Season (August). Of the ten games, up to three game assignments can be mentorship assignments.

Level 4/5

\$365.00 - The NDBA UDP will reimburse 100% of the Level 4/5, \$65.00 BCBUA membership fee, \$175.00 BCBUA clinic fee, \$75.00 National membership fee and \$50.00 BCBUA travel fund fee if the Umpire works ten (10) official NDBA UDP games for a total of \$365.00 (receipts will be required) which will be paid out at the conclusion of the NDBA UDP Summer Season (August). Of the ten games, up to three game assignments can be mentorship assignments.

These reimbursements will be made providing that you are listed as a NDBA UDP Umpire and that you are not getting any reimbursement from another association for the same fees.

Who is considered a NDBA UDP Umpire?

At the beginning of the 2024 season, the NDBA UDP Umpire-In-Chief will submit to the NDBA UDP a list of names of those individuals that are considered NDBA UDP Umpires. These individuals reside in North Delta, or have come through the NDBA UDP system and are considered NDBA UDP Umpires.

Umpire Attire

All umpires are required to wear a BCBUA shirt and grey slacks. The NDBA UDP will supply you with one shirt providing that you provide us with a \$40.00 post-dated cheque deposit. Alternatively you can purchase a shirt for \$40.00 from the NDBA UDP and each year as you outgrow said shirt, exchange it with the NDBA UDP for a larger size.

We also have some Umpire Equipment combo's (ball bag, indicator, plate brush, and hat) in stock. We will sell these combo's for \$20.00 versus the retail of \$40.00. We also have a limited stock of the grey slacks that we are selling at \$20.00.

The NDBA UDP will also supply mask/helmet, chest protector, and leg guards that are kept in storage at each playing field. However you may want to have you own personal gear. If that is the case, you can get all your needs here in North Delta from one of our own Senior Umpires, Jerry Tregaskis who manages Pro-Image Officials Supply Inc., which specializes in Umpire Equipment.
