Registration for the NRBC will be open online January 1, 2018-March 31, 2018. Regular registrations will be accepted until February 28, 2018. Late registration will begin on March 1, 2018 and will include a late fee of \$10. No registrations will be accepted after April 1st. All players must register under their CURRENT grade level. All players must have their balance paid in full from last season in order to register; any outstanding balances for registration or volunteer obligations must be paid before a registration for this season will be accepted as complete. This season we will be conducting all player skill evaluations for In House teams structured outdoor practice times-weather permitting. Historically, we have struggled with team formation due to the unpredictability of weather, so we are adjusting and conducting these simple skill evalua-

tions for team formation with an embedded rain date. These evaluations intend to gauge the level of skill development players have so that teams are formed evenly. Dates of these evaluations are April 16, 17, 18, and 19. The Rain Date is Saturday April 21 in the HS GYM, times and confirmed locations will be listed on the NRBC calendar. Coaches and league directors will form teams the week of April 22nd.

Traveling parents will have a mandatory meeting on **Monday April 9, 2018** in the Large forum room of the New Richmond High School.

All In house parents will have a mandatory parent meeting on **Tuesday April 10, 2018** in the New Richmond High School Commons. T-ball and Coach Pitch parents will meet at 6:30. Machine Pitch, Minors, Majors, and BR Par-

ents will meet at 7:30 pm. If you have players in both leagues, you only need to attend the Traveling Parent meeting.

Uniforms for all Machine Pitch, Minors, Majors, Babe Ruth, and Traveling players will be distributed on Friday night **April 27th from 6-7 pm** at The Centre. This will coincide with our third annual NRBC Equipment Sale and the New Richmond Community Baseball night. All NRBC players are asked to join the Varsity players on the field after they take on the Somerset Spartans for an all-club photo.

The first games for all In House teams will be held during Baseball Weekend in New Richmond, which is scheduled for **May 11-12, 2018** at Hatfield. All teams will have scheduled practices or games that weekend along with having their team photos taken. Regular In House game schedules begin the week of **May 15, 2018**.

THESE ARE NOT REQUIREMENTS, NOR SHOULD YOU PURCHASE THESE ITEMS SPECIFICALLY UNLESS YOU INTENDED TO UPDATE YOUR EQUIPMENT ALREADY. HOWEVER, IF YOU ARE REPLACING OR UPDATING YOUR EQUIPMENT, WE HOPE YOU WILL CONSIDER THESE SUGGESTIONS, WHICH ARE BASED ON GUIDELINES APPLIED AT THE VARSITY BASEBALL LEVEL:

1. *HELMETS- MATTE BLACK*
2. *PANTS- GREY WITH BLACK PIPING*
3. *CLEATS- PRIMARILY BLACK IN COLOR*

NRBC TRAVELING TEAMS COMPETING IN THE MBL AGAIN THIS SEASON



The New Richmond Baseball Club fields traveling teams at 6 different age levels. We have one AA team at the U10, U11, U12, U13, and U14 levels and an A team at the U10, U11, and U12, and a AAA team at the U13 level. Our traveling program has nearly doubled in the last three years! This season, the NRBC will once again be participating in the Metro Baseball League. Traveling coaches will attend a scheduling meeting this spring and once games are established, we will post schedules on the website immediately. If you have any questions regarding the traveling league, contact league director Brad Altena.

Is your child in third grade this school year? Would you like a taste of what the traveling baseball program feels like before tryouts for U10 next summer? We have a 'hybrid' traveling baseball tournament opportunity at the U9 level each summer. Indicate **on your registration form** that you would like to have your child evaluated during the In House team evaluations this spring. All interested third graders will be grouped together where their skills will be observed by coaches. Players who will compete on the U 9 team will play in the Minors program **while** also participating in 2-3 additional tournaments throughout the summer. Participants must meet a baseline skill evaluation and there is an additional cost of \$75.00. This added fee covers uniforms and additional tournament fees. Players who meet the baseline skill level will be sent a registration link after evaluations.



T-BALL AND COACH PITCH SCHEDULES

Once again this season the NRBC T-Ball program will hold all practices and games on MONDAY nights. Likewise, the Coach Pitch program will hold all practices and games on TUESDAY nights. This is a change from two years ago where families would be able to select one or the other for each program. We believe

this will help in the development of league schedules because all teams will be able to compete against one another on the same evening. Families will also benefit from the ability to concentrate on one level each evening.

All T-ball and Coach Pitch families are invited to the Community Baseball night on

Friday April 27, 2018 where they will be able to meet their coach, collect their uniforms, and take part in the club-wide photo with Varsity players.

WE NEED YOUR HELP

The New Richmond Baseball Club is run entirely by volunteers who believe in the mission of promoting a positive baseball experience for the youth of New Richmond. Each season we ask parents to help by shouldering some of the responsibilities.

If you register one child in the Minors, Majors, and Babe Ruth programs, we ask you to volunteer 6 hours. If you register two children in the Minors, Majors, or Babe Ruth programs, we ask you to volunteer 8 hours. If you register three or more children in the Minors, Majors, and Babe Ruth programs, we ask you to volunteer 10 hours. Traveling families will work all available concession shifts during home games as well as 10-12 hours during their home tournament weekends and do not have the buyout option. **If you did NOT elect to 'buyout' the volunteer hours and do not fulfill the requirement through the season, you will be charged the buyout fee AND an additional \$50 penalty fee at the end of the season.** This balance must be paid in full before your child will be placed on a team next season.

Throughout the season you will have several opportunities to satisfy this expectation. The NRBC utilizes the SPORT NGIN web tool 'dibs' to list and assign volunteer positions through the season. However, we are always seeking additional hands on deck whenever work needs to be done behind the scenes. So much time is spent organizing and cleaning equipment, reserving fields, ordering/organizing/distributing uniforms, completing field preparations and assignments, making decisions regarding weather and scheduling, fundraising via concessions and apparel sales, promoting NRBC events, facilitating clinics and coaches training, organizing and facilitating tournaments, oversight of leagues, training/scheduling/overseeing umpires, etc. The NRBC invites you to reach out to one of the di-
