It appears that the bracket type will be adjusted to the number of wrestlers with a scramble-type format (like Winnebago) most likely. This means that each wrestler should get the most wrestling possible for the number of wrestlers there, up to 5 matches.

This is a varsity tournament, but if we are allowed to, it's possible we may ask a JV wrestler or two to participate.

### **Note on weather conditions:**

- If school is cancelled due to weather, all competitions and practices are also automatically cancelled/postponed.
- If an evening event is cancelled/postponed during the school day, that notification will go out in several different ways, including this email list.
- Saturday tournaments are usually not cancelled due to weather unless it is very extreme - they cannot really be made up. If I find out the morning of the tournament that it has been cancelled, I will send out an email to this list as soon as I can.
