Meeting Minutes

February 6, 2013

Call to order: Josh Burnham called to order the regular meeting of the SAC at 8:45pm on February 6, 2013 via teleconference.

Roll call: The following persons were present: Josh Burnham, Denny Allen, Sharon Mozer, and Dennis Berry.

Open issues

1. A correction from January 9th minutes regarding Sanction fee: It was printed that the sanction fee for a meet is \$85.00 and \$115.00 for late applications – The correct information is the sanction fee has been increased from \$85.00 to \$115.00.
2. State Clinic/Camp
 - a. Proposed dates for the State Camp in June are: the weekend of 14th, 15th, 16th, or the weekend of 21st, 22nd, 23rd. Josh will contact Becky Remmel to give her these dates to work on.
 - b. Josh or Denny will contact Becky Remmel for updates on the planning process, budget, and the basic structure of the clinic.
 - c. Mismo will have a summer camp in the last weekend in June so the above-proposed dates will not pose a conflict.
3. New Levels/Changes for next year
 - a. Would it be helpful and should the state put together guidelines for Montana gyms on what skills are recommended at each level? The SAC can come up with recommendations following along with the national board.
4. State Meet verification on qualified scores. There is no system in place to verify gymnasts who have qualified to the State Championships. Josh will send out communication to gyms requesting that the Monday following the last 'in-state' meet – each gym has to send proper documentation including name of gymnast, level, which meet, and score. Josh will verify information prior to the State Championships.
5. State Admin Tax – Josh will send out an email to remind gyms to pay. Gyms can either write a check at the State Championships or send a payment prior to state.

New Business

1. Level 3 to rank in the AA at the State Championships.

2. Level 3 Judging – parents are complaining that judging is inconsistent and would like to see adults judging. The board will discuss and consider issue, also will consider having former gymnasts or high level gymnast judge as well.
3. State Championship competition rotation. Because the State Championship is under the jurisdiction of the SAC, LMG is putting together the competition schedule and the board

will review for approval.

4. Each level of discipline (Levels 3-10) will have 10 gymnasts per age division for the purpose of awards at the State Championships.

- a. Josh will email Region II Championships - Team Entry and Athletic Entry Forms to gyms to fill out for potential qualifiers prior to the State Championships to be efficient and save time at the State meet.

- b. The SAC traditionally award gifts to each senior as a special souvenir
- c. In past years, the SAC has awarded necklaces
