Code of Conduct

The Board of Directors of the Duarte Youth Athletic Club has adopted the following Code of Conduct for Managers/Coaches/Volunteers participating in Duarte Youth Athletic Club/Duarte ASA Softball games, events, and activities and Official Representatives of Duarte Youth Athletic Club/Duarte ASA Softball. Duarte Youth Athletic Club is designed to provide an experience that is positive, safe, developmental, and fun for the players.

The team Managers/Coaches as representatives of DYAC shall. By his or her actions and conduct, set an example for the players under his or her care. The Board of Directors of Duarte Youth Athletic Club will take ZERO TOLERANCE in the event of a violation of the Manager/Coach/Volunteers Code of Conduct.

Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

1. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers will lead by example and will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, managers, coaches, umpires, and league officials at every practice, game, or league event.
2. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall treat each player as an individual, taking into consideration the wide range of emotional and physical development that may exist for players on the same team.
3. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall not use profanity at any time during a game or practice or within the presence of any player on any team.
4. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall treat players, other Managers/Coaches/Volunteers, umpires, league officials, parents, and spectators with respect.
5. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall not abuse equipment or facilities in an obvious display of anger.
6. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall do their best to provide a safe playing situation for players.
7. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall not verbally abuse, threaten, or engage in torturous physical contact with any player, manager, coach, volunteer, spectator, umpire, league official, parent, or any other individual under any circumstances.
8. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall use coaching techniques that are appropriate for the skills being taught.
9. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall not use tobacco on the field during any practice or game.
10. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall not be under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicant at any time while coaching, attending a DYAC/Duarte ASA Softball event, or while otherwise representing DYAC/Duarte ASA Softball.
11. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall be knowledgeable of the rules of baseball or softball within the division that they Managers/Coaches/Volunteer and shall teach these rules to the players.
12. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall follow the rules, regulations, and policies of the Duarte Youth Athletic Club/Duarte ASA Softball.
13. Managers/Coaches/Volunteers shall not conduct themselves in any manner detrimental to DYAC, Duarte ASA Softball, or PONY Baseball Inc.
