



## PLAYERS TRAVEL RULES – 2017/2018 SEASON

Each player must comply with these ten simple rules whenever we travel as a team. Also, we will operate under an Honor Code; which means that it is each player's responsibility to report to your team administrator and head coach any violation of these rules. (This includes your own violation, if there is one.) In this way, we watch out for each other and make sure we do the right thing when we have choices.

1. **No boys in any girl's hotel room or any other room with girls. No girls in any boy's hotel room or other room with boys.** No alcohol, cigarettes or drugs are allowed. A violation of this rule will result in disqualification from all further play. In addition, any violator will be returned to her parents, whether the parents are traveling with the team or at home.
2. **Never leave the hotel, the field, or any other place the team visits without permission from your team manager or coach.** *This includes taking rides with your parents or other parents.* Your team administrator must know the exact location of all players at all times. Permission must be received before you go anywhere, not while you are in transit.
3. **Always travel in groups of two or more players.** Basically, don't go anywhere by yourself.
4. **Be on time.** All players will receive and must follow their team schedule. There will be many scheduled times to meet, to travel, to eat, to go to bed, etc. It is your responsibility to be on time. Excuses are not accepted. Failure to do so will result in suspension.
5. **Follow the Honor Code.** It is a test of personal courage, character, and recognition that we are all dependent on one another to do the right thing for the good of the team. In this spirit, it is your obligation as a group to assist each other in ensuring that we operate under the Honor Code and all travel rules are followed.
6. **Remember that you are an ambassador.** You, your teammates, and the club will be judged based on your conduct. Try to work towards acting in a way that shows your pride and good character. Where you are in the hotel, at the airport, at a restaurant, or on the field. Let's show the soccer community that our excellence as a team extends beyond the way we play the game.
7. **All team events are mandatory (meals, activities, practices, etc.) – no exceptions.**
8. **Room visitations: Are not allowed by non-team members.** Only the appropriately cleared chaperone or administrator may visit the players' rooms and should not enter except for emergency. Rule of 2 #3.
9. **Cell phone/ laptop rules:** No cell phone or laptop usage after lights out. Any breach of these rules will result in your cell phone/laptop confiscated for the remainder of the trip. Each team coach/administrator will make an independent decision as to whether cell phones/laptops are turned in at night.
10. **Dress Code:** When traveling as a group, players will wear common FPSC Fury attire. When not in uniform, you will dress conservatively. No booty shorts.
