Summer League 199 Teams – Less 19 teams from 2016
Fall League 13 Teams – Less 11 teams from 2016

Summer League 2,930 players registered – less 310 player registrations from 2016
Fall League 156 players registered – approximately 150 less players than 2016

- Upper division tournaments saw an increase in size, especially on the men's size. This year's men's tournaments were some of the largest in recent memory and were not dominated by any one team, it was a good mix all around.
- Lower division tournaments still very low, cancelled several tournaments due to lack of team interest.
- The new LCS triple elimination format appeared to be a success and I see those tournaments only getting better.
- Stabilizer installed on C5 and C6 drastically reduced the number of games cancelled this season.
