**NAME:** This non-profit corporation shall be called Slinger Gridiron Club, Inc. (SGC). This organization is a member of the All American Youth Football League (AAYFL), as well as participation in the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA), North Shore Conference.

**PURPOSE:** This organization shall provide, or otherwise support the opportunity for 5<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade, youth and teens, residing within and / or attending the Slinger School District, to participate in the sport of tackle football. This organization shall be responsible for the assistance and direction necessary to run a successful youth football program. In addition, SGC will support both the Slinger High School football program as well as the youth football program monetarily as both programs continue to expand.

**EMPHASIS:** The emphasis of this program shall be to instruct all members of the youth teams in the proper techniques of football and sportsmanship. Teamwork, commitment, and fair play shall be required, at all times, from all Directors, Coaches, and Players. The SGC will further encourage the High School program to follow the same ideals outlined and agreed by their player in the Slinger High School Athletic Code of Conduct.

**GOALS:** To teach, develop, promote and regulate the sport of tackle football for players residing in and / or attending the Slinger School District. To provide a program which is a positive experience for all members. The character built from participation in the organization shall always be the primary goal. The program will encourage a spirit of competition and a will to win, provide each participant the opportunity to develop the attributes of good sportsmanship and fun, and the camaraderie associated with playing organized football. The program will work to develop qualities of leadership, teamwork, discipline, quickness of mind, physical well-being, and moral as well as physical courage. SGC will also work to instill the knowledge that the dedicated hard work and perseverance can often compensate for limited natural ability and instill in the athletes a proper competitive spirit and desire to perform to capacity both as individuals and as a team.
