COMMITMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into for the purpose of explaining All Star tournament play and defining the terms and conditions of player, parent and manager/coach participation. In consideration of the mutual promise of all players to play to the best of their ability, the parents to support the player positively, the manager and coaches to supervise all team activities responsibly and the Board of Directors of Mira Mesa Girls Softball to sponsor the tournament team, all parties understand and agree as follows:

- 1) **ALL STAR PROCEDURE & ELIGIBILITY** - All Stars is a separate team and tournament from the regular softball season and comes under separate tournament rules and guidelines as defined in the Southern California USA Softball Regulations & Rules. All Stars is considered post season tournament play and the emphasis is on developing players to win tournaments. All teams begin play at district level, advance to state, regional and national tournaments. Players are selected based on eligibility (age), availability and playing skills. A player must also have participated in at least 70 percent of the regular season games to be eligible. The age criterion is defined as the player's age on December 31, 2018.
- 2) **TEAM SELECTION** - All players that complete an application will be asked to attend a mandatory evaluation, date to be determined. Players will be evaluated by all managers/coaches and then those coaches/managers will hold a draft based on the evaluation of the players for their respective age divisions and will be placed on their team.
- 3) **CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTING NOMINATION TO ALL STARS** - This agreement contains the conditions of participation, and each player and his/her parent or parents and the team manager. Each must understand and agree to abide by these terms and conditions. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action taken against the violating party and could result in suspension or dismissal from the team as approved by the Board of Directors.
 - a) **PLAYER COMMITMENT** - Your Managers and coaches are honoring you as a regular season player for your commitment to excellence and as a potential member of the tournament team. Your selection as an All Star is not a right, but a privilege. You are expected to play fair and strive to win, but win or lose you will always do your best. You will be positive and motivational to your fellow players, respectful of the coaching staff, all parents, tournament officials, umpires and everyone you encounter. You represent the Mira Mesa Girls Softball and our tradition and reputation of excellence in tournament play. You are expected to uphold this tradition and reputation.
 - b) **PLAYER PARTICIPATION** - **No guarantees** are made to anyone as to a specific amount of playing time. The manager and coaches of the team will make that determination. You are expected to be part of the team for the duration of tournament play. Your position on the field and in the batting order will be earned through hard work, ability, a positive mental attitude and specific needs in a given game situation as determined by the manager and coaches of the team. You will attend all tournament games and are expected to be part of the team for the duration of tournament play.
 - c) **PRACTICES** - will be held according to the schedule established by the coaching staff. Each team's practices generally start in May. Multiple practices may be held on selected days. Each player will commit to participate in all practices unless prior notice and permission is obtained from the manager or coach. Depending on the division there may be less than two weeks allowed for preparation before play begins.
 - d) **PARENTAL COMMITMENT** - Each parent is made a party of this commitment agreement along with the players, manager and coach as well as the Board of Directors for the purpose of enlisting the common support of everyone involved in All Star Tournament play. All parents agree to adopt the provisions of the Commitment Agreement for the support of team members, coaching staff, all other parents, the Board of Directors of Mira Mesa Girls Softball and anyone else involved in All Star Play.
 - e) **FINANCIAL COMMITMENT** - The fee to participate on an All-Star team is **\$300.00** per player (non-refundable), this fee will cover the cost of entry fees for a guaranteed five (5) tournaments and a possible 6th tournament, (1) Bracket jersey, (1) Pool play jersey, (1) pair of pants, (1) helmet, (2) pairs of socks, (1) bow and a basic picture packet. Payments must be made by check or cash and are due in full by May 4th. Payment plans are available.
 - f) **Each player must have parent(s) work at the MMGS Runway Class tournament.** MMGS will require a \$50.00 (fifty dollar) deposit from all parents. All deposits will be held and NOT deposited if the parent fulfills their time allotment. Should the parent NOT full their time allotments, MMGS WILL DEPOSIT THE \$50.00 - NO EXCEPTIONS! No snack bar buy outs are allowed, hours must be fulfilled.
 - g) **CODE OF CONDUCT/PARENT MEETING** - Each parent must attend a mandatory parent meeting and understand the codes of conduct set forth. MMGS has a no tolerance rule for outbursts or inappropriate behavior by both the players and parents. Any act of behavior that could potentially affect the League's future will be addressed by the Board of Directors and a determined resolution will be issued. Parent meeting will take place May 4th, Time and place to be determined.
 - h) **ALL STAR FEES** - Any questions regarding All Star fees are to be discussed with the Board of Directors. Please note that the fees assessed are based on entry fees for each tournament per team entered, uniforms provided, player insurance and pictures for the All Star season.
