Practice Packs – Mandatory Fall 2018

- All players are required to purchase practice packs.
- Available for purchase on BSN Team Store
- Only have to purchase them once
- Items can be omitted if you already have them ex. girdle
- Can put your own number on the jersey

Items include

- Practice jersey (Nike)
- Practice pants
- Girdle
- Knee pads
- Practice t-shirt
- Practice shorts





2018 OVERVIEW AND EXPECTATIONS

- Players are not allowed to miss any practices unless cleared **ahead of time** by Coach Strine
- If a player misses practice they must run 50 hills before they are allowed to participate in any games. (conditioning for what was missed)
- If a player misses multiple practices without clearing it by me first parents will be called in for a meeting with Coach Strine – we will discuss the way and determine the best course of action together.





2018 OVERVIEW AND EXPECTATIONS

- Expectations During Off Season – To be Elite & Win we have to Work Together
- Safety is #1 concern – the staff is committed to taking all steps in preventing injury
- To play football, players will need to participate in off-season program
- Guardians – issued to each player, collected
NO GUARDIAN CAP = NO PRACTICE
- Tangela and April are our team trainers employed by Emory Health Care
- Bring an extra inhaler/medication to be kept by our Trainers

- Parent and Player Register for a Privit accounts online.
- Fill out Health History, Personal Information, & FCS Forms online.
- Join your team online.]
- Print your Pre-Participation Health History and bring it to your physical
- After the physician's exam, use your phone to photograph and upload your:
 1. physician's exam,
 2. physician's clearance &
 3. insurance card

▪ Benefits

- Each year you will only update information for all sports played
- You can copy information to siblings at same school
- Coaches can easily review your paperwork
- No more lost paperwork
- Players are easily cleared to play.
