2018 ASA Eligibility Rules

- 12U must be born in 2005 or later
- 10U must be born in 2007 or later
- 8U must be born in 2009 or later

*Must have played on a FC Spring team in 2018

Cannot have played on Travel Team or A-ball
game after 3/31/18 (umpire present)

**Note - Girls from other cities can be taken if not
enough girls try out from Foster City*



Try-outs

- Players must try-out to make a team
 - 8U Saturday April 28th 9:00am – 10:30pm, Boothbay Park
 - 10U Sunday April 29th 10:00am - 12:00pm, Sea Cloud B2
 - 12U Sunday April 29rd 2:00pm - 4:00pm, Sea Cloud B2

**Note – Dates and times are subject to change. Please check our website (fcysa.org) for any updates*
- All players must have a completed application to try out
- Fees are collected when player is selected, not at the try-out
- Must notify the league in advance if you cannot make tryouts, but are interested in playing Flash. Make-up dates will be determined based on need

How Teams are Selected

- After the try-out there is a selection meeting, typically the night after the tryout
- The head coach and the league make the determinations
- Selection is based on commitment, availability, performance at the try-out and play during the season



Commitment

- Tournament ball is 5-6 days a week, for 10U and 12U and up to 4 days a week for 8U
- Players must be very motivated and committed
- Playing time is earned
- Playing time is not guaranteed and is not equal
- Uncommitted players will not enjoy this program
- Players have to want it, not just the parents
