## **Boys Gymnastics**

Senior Lucas Pauker qualified to the IHSA state tournament for the fourth year in a row and competed this past weekend.

As a freshman he qualified on one event, two events as a sophomore, five events and the all-around as a junior, and made all six events and the all-around this season. What progress!

This year Lucas placed 15th in the all-around and improved on last seasons state finals on one event by qualifying to the state finals in three events. In these state finals he then placed 12th on vault, 8th on parallel bars, and 4th on the pommel horse.

Lucas is one of only a handful of Glenbrook South gymnasts to ever qualify to the state finals on three or more events.

At the IHSA Boys Gymnastics Senior All-Star meet, Pauker won the pommel horse and tied for first on the vault to help the CSL conference win the All-Star meet.

What an incredible career for our Stanford-bound gymnast!

## **Girls Soccer Wins Regional**

The GBS Girls Varsity Soccer team captured their 15th IHSA Regional title in school history on Saturday to move to 19-3-5 for the season.

On Wednesday, took on the 14th seeded Leyden Eagles out of Franklin Park in the IHSA Regional Semifinals at Glenbrook North and won decisively, 5-0.

After a 0-0 halftime deadlock, the Titans blasted through with five second-half goals. Sophomore midfielder/forward Ellie Flowers got the team on the board from a senior midfielder Annie McMahon assist in the 42nd minute. Then, junior midfielder Julia DiSano added back-to-back goals both from Flowers in the 55th and 57th minutes. JV call-up and sophomore midfielder Sydney Boland chipped the goalkeeper from 25 yards in the 67th minute. Finally, freshman forward Grace Diehl added the final goal from a senior forward Hailey Kraabel assist in the 68th minute. Goalkeepers junior Libbie Vanderveen (1 save) and sophomore Jessica Ehlinger (0 saves) shared the shutout.

Saturday, the IHSA Class 3A Regional Championship title was on the line with the Titans taking on Glenbrook North for a third time this season. GBN (11-3-4) prior to the game was ranked #40 in the nation, 11th in the Midwest region, and #7 in Illinois (TopDrawerSoccer.com). The Titans were 0-1-1 going into the match versus the Spartans but held strong being #20 in the Midwest and #9 in Illinois.

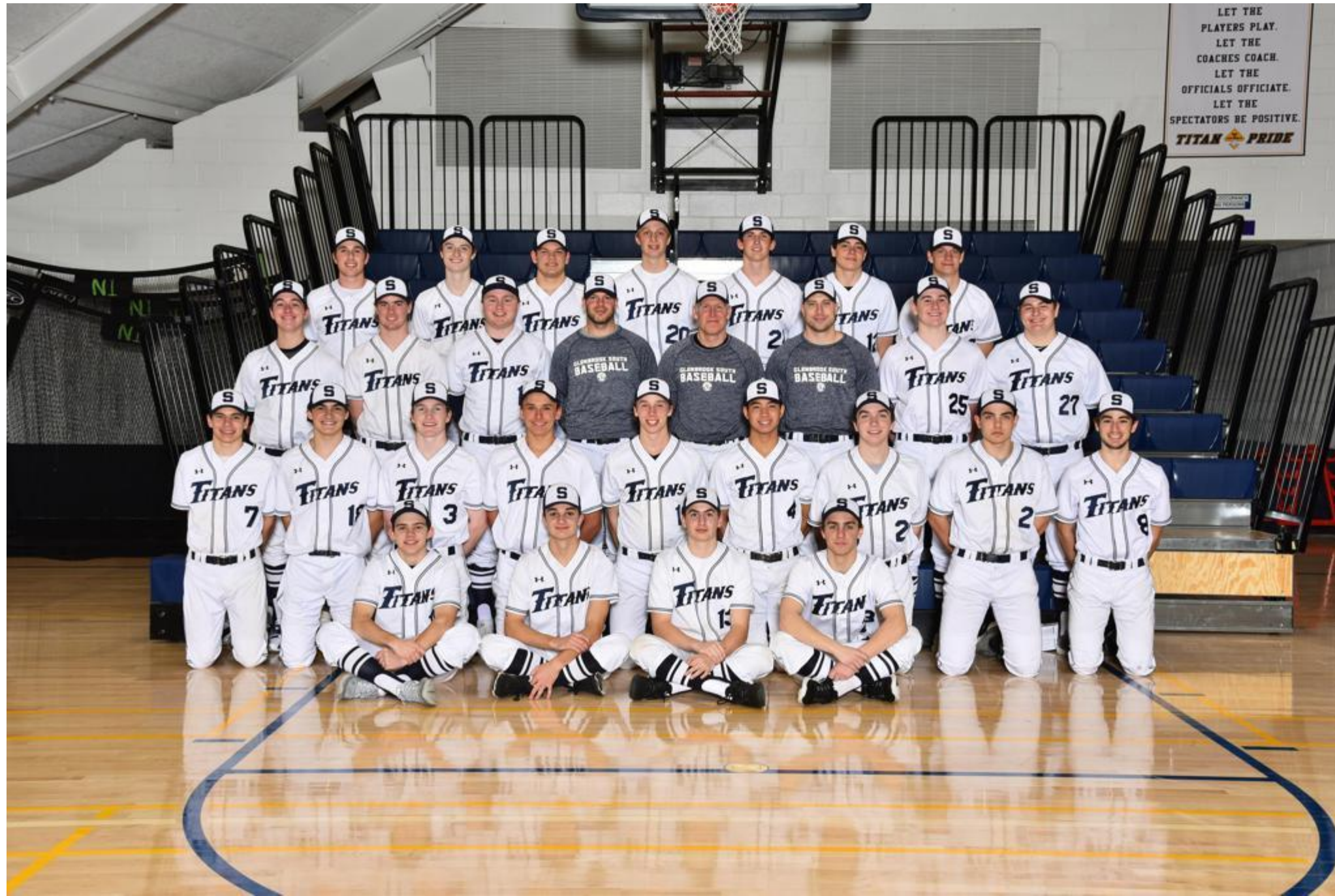
The team's back-and-forth play defined much of the match until the 66th minute in which junior defender Gracie O'Brien played a 30-yard pass along the left touchline. Junior forward Makayla Stadler then beat two GBN defenders on her way to earning her 16th goal of the season and the game winning goal for the title. Vanderveen made three saves for her 9th shutout of the campaign including a huge save in the second half on GBN's Emily Charen to preserve the game.

GBS will host the IHSA Sectionals (3rd and 4th round) on Tuesday, May 22, and Friday, May 25.

The Titans will next play #4 Loyola Academy at 6:30 p.m., on Tuesday, in the IHSA Sectional Semifinals.

The Girls Track & Field season ended Saturday at the 2018 IHSA Girls State Track & Field Championship meet. The Titans sectional qualifiers competed in the prelims on Friday, May 19th.

Congratulations to Senior **Emily Noone** and Sophomore **Raelyn Roberson** for qualifying to the finals on Saturday. The Titans finished the weekend with a top 10 performance and a State Runner-up.

Emily Noone qualified with the 12th best time out of the 32 qualifiers going into Friday's prelims. She ran a season's best 2 minutes 16.82 seconds in her prelim heat. Emily competed and gave it her best, finishing in 10th place.

Raelyn Roberson qualified with the 4th best jump out of the 43 qualifiers going into Friday's prelims. Raelyn jumped her personal best 19 feet 4 inches, which earned her 2nd place and a spot on the podium.

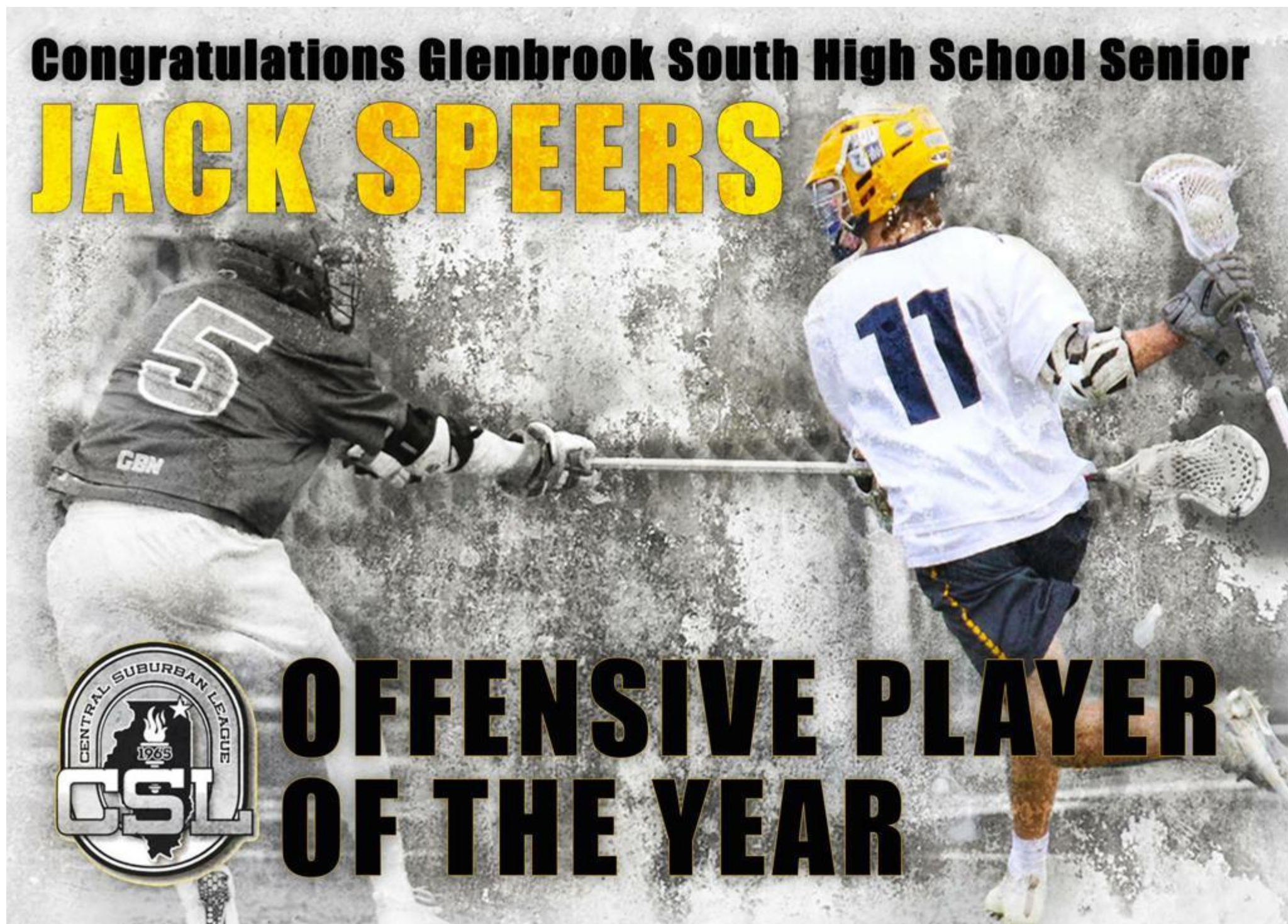

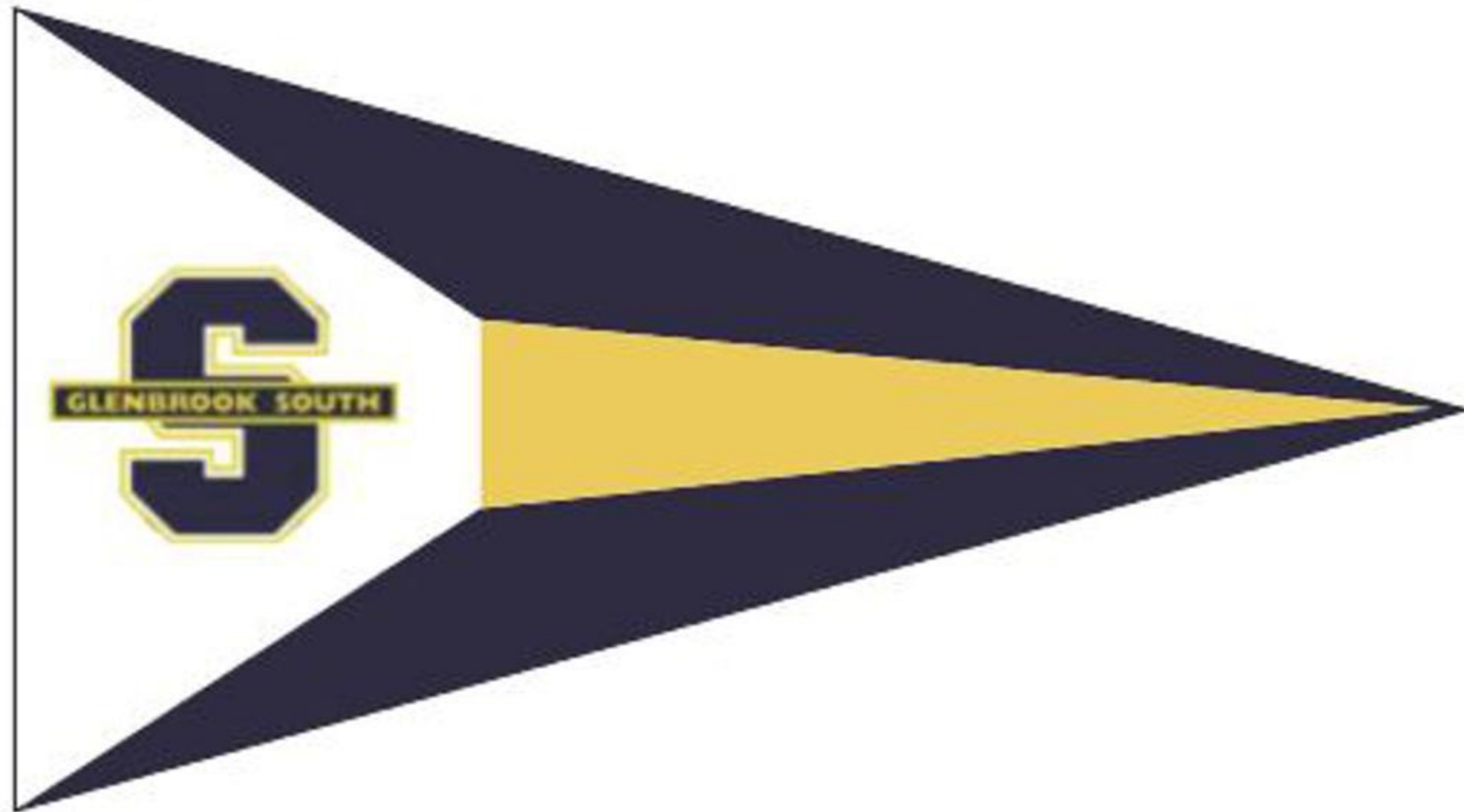
**Alumni Update: Jason Paek**

GBS alum and University of Rochester senior captain golfer Jason Paek was named to the PING Division III All-Northeast Region team in 2018 as announced by the Golf Coaches Association of America this week.

Paek was also named the Liberty League Conference Player of the Year and was selected to the conference's All-League 1st Team. He was also awarded a spot on the GCAA's Srixon/Cleveland Golf All-America Scholar squad for his efforts in the classroom. In addition, the senior was a 1st Team All-UAA choice after having a career season in 2017-18.

This year, Paek paced University of Rochester with a 75.40 scoring average, over two strokes better than his previous best season. He competed in nine events and carded 20 rounds overall, posting five top-10s, three top-5s and two wins. He came in first at not only the Liberty League Fall Preview but was also the medalist at this past 2018 Liberty League Spring Conference Championship. J

Paek is ranked 80th in Division III's individual golfstat rankings following the season.
