Please note the following:

1. **Scratches:** Please meet at 8:00am with Lyle McKellar at the Awards tent.
2. **Officials' Meeting:** 8:30am at the Awards tent
3. **Admissions/Registration**
 - Athletes/coaches will be directed to enter through the main entrance of the Art Hauser Arena. Signage will lead you to the arena floor where tables will be set up for each district.
 - Coaches are asked to send the entire athlete delegation through the lines rather than the coaches picking up all of the athlete wristbands.
 - a. **Competitors**
 - i. **Registration**
 1. **Friday 7:30am - 12:00pm**
 - a. Athlete registration will take place on the rink floor of the Art Hauser Center.
 - b. Identify yourself by name and district and you will be directed to the proper table to receive a wrist band that will allow you to enter the facility free of charge.
 - c. The **wristband must be worn the entire meet**. Failure to show your admission wristband will result in admission being collected.
 2. **Saturday 7:30am - 10:00am**
 - a. Athlete registration will take place on the rink floor of the Art Hauser Center.
 - ii. **Late Registration**
 1. **Friday after 12:00pm and all day Saturday**
 - a. Late registration Friday and all day Saturday will be placed at the **Admission table located at the East end of the Art Hauser Center**.
 - b. **Coaches**
 - i. **Registration**
 1. You will be required to register in the same manner as the athletes (see times and procedures as noted above).
 - c. **General Public**
 - i. Admission gates are located at the east end of the Art Hauser Center and the north end of the track adjacent to Terry Simpson Lane.
 - ii. Adult admission: \$7.00 per day. Student admission: \$5.00 per day.
 - iii. A two-day wrist band can be purchased on Friday.
4. **Programs**
 - a. Available free of charge at the admissions gate while supplies last.
5. **Washrooms**
 - a. Washroom facilities are located:
 - i. under in the Art Hauser Center at the main concession inside the main entrance on the west side of the building
 - ii. the south east corner of the Art Hauser Center
 - iii. porta-potties located at both ends of the track
6. **Coaches Meeting**
 - a. Saturday, June 2nd during the break.
 - b. This meeting will take place in the CPAC foyer/gymnasium.
 - c. District coaches (2 per district) will be provided with free lunch (Pizza Hut).

7. Marshalling of Athletes

- a. Field events will be marshaled at the event site.
- b. Track events will be marshaled at the marshaling tent located by the 100m start line (north end).

8. Medal and Ribbon Presentations

- a. Field Events
 - i. At the conclusion of each field event, the head official will be requested to bring the top competitors (1st – 8th) to the awards tent. Then the head official will give the results sheet to the results runners who will take the sheets to the finish line booth. Ribbons will be presented to finishers 4 – 8 while medals will be presented to the top 3.
- b. Track Events
 - i. Within ½ hour of the conclusion of each track event, the top 8 competitors will be called to the Awards tent/Podium for presentations.
- c. **Please remind your athletes they must wear their District uniform for award presentations.**

9. **Sask Milk** will be providing free milk to athletes throughout the competition. Milk distribution will be located at the awards tent as well as there will be volunteers circulating the facility handing milk out.

10. Concessions

- a. A Concession will be available in the main concession area of the Art Hauser located inside the main doors on the west side of the building. There will also be a secondary concession located on the south east corner of the Art Hauser Center.

11. Reminders

- a. All throwing events are located outside the track on the northeast end.
- b. The Junior Quad shot put will take place in the discus throwing area.
- c. Spectators are **not** allowed on the infield. All viewing by the public is from the stands.
- d. Athletes will have areas sectioned off that they need to stay in while competing. Coaches will not be allowed in these areas, but they can come and speak with their athletes outside of the roped off area.
- e. Tents are allowed around the perimeter of the facility but no one is allowed on the infield.
- f. We encourage all competitors, coaches, and fans to bring plenty of sunscreen, wear a hat and to drink plenty of fluids.
- g. Footballs, Frisbees, etc. are not allowed.
- h. Carlton School is off limits to all competitors.
- i. Clothing sales from Sport Logo will be available just inside the main admission tables located on the east side of the Art Hauser Center.
- j. Live results will be available all weekend within minutes of the event finishing. There is a link on the SHSAA website (www.shsaa.ca) to results on the PA Athletics website (www.paathletics.ca) under Live Results.
- k. Results and heat sheets will also be posted on the back of the Finish Line building.
- l. Athletes' belonging will be transported by volunteers from the start line to the finish line for the hurdles, 100m, and 200m events.

12. Parking

- a. Please see the parking and facility map on the SHSAA website.
 - i. Parking is encouraged in the Art Hauser parking lots on both days and in the Carlton school parking lots on Saturday only.
 - ii. Bus parking is available in the south lot of the Art Hauser Center. Please try and park on the east side of this lot.

13. Medical Facilities

- a. All coaches should equip themselves with the standard first-aid supplies **including tape**, as with any other activity. Ice will be available and a physiotherapist will be on site.
- b. The physio will be based out of the Summer Games Sports Center located on the southwest end of the track.
