Boys Soccer

The Boys soccer team wrapped up a historic season losing in the Sectionals to Evanston, 2-1. The Titans had clawed their way into the sectional, surviving both of their regional games in the last minute and almost did so against the Wildkits.

"[The match] was an emotional rollercoaster," senior captain Jimmy McMahon told the Glenview Lantern. "I love the ways our boys fought tonight. They didn't give up until the last second of the whistle. We've had a lot of comebacks this year, and I'm just glad we put it all on the line."

"I was so proud of the resilience the entire year," head coach Reggie Lara said. "Last year, we had these achievements and we couldn't bounce back. That's what I wanted to preach to these guys all season."

GBS won the Titan Invite, finished second in the Central Suburban League South to eventual CSL champion New Trier and won its first regional title in seven years.
