TRIA Rink Covid-19 User Guidelines

Effective April 14, 2021

For the safety of athletes and guests along with our employees, TRIA Rink is following all health restrictions by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH).

Furthermore, TRIA Rink is following all CDC and MDH guidance in regards to facility cleaning and sanitizing practices.

Currently MDH regulations only allow:

- a maximum of (2) separate groups of up to (25) on the ice at any time for practices. This includes coaches and players. These groups are not to intermingle except during games/scrimmages.
- Games are permitted at this time.
- Limited capacity locker room usage. Groups will be assigned a large and small locker room and (1) group of chairs in the rink changing areas on the window end of the rink.
- Strict 10 minute entry and exit prior and post ice time. **Please be timely on exit, the next group is depending on it.**
- **Masks are required at all time on and off the ice.**
- Maximum of 150 in attendance at any point in time. And properly distance. *SEE FACILITY MANDATE SECTION FOR MORE DETAIL.*

All users will need to provide their organization/group Covid-19 plan to ensure they are safeguarding the health and safety of each of their users and facility staff to ensure no one is ill or symptomatic.

- Each participant to complete a self-health survey prior to arrival. (Ensuring they do not have any of the symptoms of Covid-19:
 - Cough/shortness of breath
 - Fever/chills - temperature under 100.
 - New muscle aches
 - New headache
 - Los of smell or taste
- Must describe how users are to ensure and comply with social distancing restrictions while in the facility.
- Proper notification to users and facility of anyone testing positive in your group.
- User contacts must have Names and contact information of **all** visiting the facility including spectators during your reservation for proper contact tracing.

Facility Mandated Policies

- Each person entering the facility will be required to wear a face covering at all times within the facility.
- Users may have to come to the rink dressed to ensure limited time exposure within the facility.
- There will be a limited amount of time prior to and following the start and end of the ice time and must exit the facility within that time frame in order to allow the next group to enter the facility. **Per MDH – 10 minutes entry and exit.**
- No spitting on players benches to prevent the spread of germs.
- Proper social distancing must be maintained on the players benches at all times.
- Spectators will be allowed – (1) spectator of adult age will be permitted entry during practices. (4) spectators of adult age will be permitted during games. **AT NO TIME SHALL THERE BE MORE THAN 150 IN ATTENDANCE AT ANY POINT. Rental contact must have a roster of all in attendance to provide to MDH for proper contact tracing.**
- No standing in the hallways, lobbys or vestibules.
- Groups seated on the players bench side chairs will enter and exit the ice via the players benches. Those seated in the concessions side of the facility will enter and exit through the tunnels in main corridor.

What TRIA Rink is doing to ensure a safe and clean facility:

- Enhanced sanitization of touch points. (Handrails, door knobs, restrooms, etc.)
- Locker room sanitization between each group.
- Hand sanitizer stations located throughout the facility.
- Touch free entrance doors, hand wash sinks, restroom facilities, paper towel dispensers, water bottle fillers, soap dispensers.
- Drinking fountains will be out of service during this time. No touch bottle fillers are still active.
- Enhanced locker room air flows and air exchange in all areas of the facility.
- Full facility sanitization at the end of the day.

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
