In appreciation of that time and support, Bellevue Soccer Clubs awards a \$1,000 educational scholarship to two deserving individuals who have also helped to develop the growth and passion of soccer in the community. Applications are currently being accepted for this year's scholarship.

Scholarship Qualifications:

- Primary player on a Bellevue Soccer Club soccer team, referee at Bellevue Soccer Club, TOPS Soccer Buddy, or trainer (such as Micro) during their senior year
- At least three total years in Nebraska as a primary player on Bellevue Soccer Club teams
- Applicant must graduate high school and be accepted to a college, university, or technical school.

A complete application must include:

- History with the Bellevue Soccer Club
- Current Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Community/Volunteer Service
- College plans (with letters of acceptance)
- Letter of recommendation from a current or past Bellevue Soccer Club coach

Applications not including all the above information will not be considered. All applications must be returned to the Bellevue Soccer Club Scholarship committee by February 28, 2019. E-mail completed applications to vsmeby@bscneb.org or send them to:

All applications received by February 28, 2019, will be reviewed by the Awards Committee. Scholarship selection will be announced no later than March 31, 2019. Scholarship will be paid to the school the player will be attending for tuition, books, room and board, or fees. The selected recipient(s) will need to submit a copy of his or her registration receipt, or similar verification of intent to attend, to BSC Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 692, Bellevue, NE, 68005. After this information is received, a check will be mailed to the school.
