It is a privilege to play volleyball at Waukesha West. As a Wolverine, I will:

1. Leave the program better than it was when I joined.
2. Respect the game of volleyball and play the game fairly.
3. Conduct myself with honor and integrity and treat other players, coaches, officials, and fans as I would like to be treated.
4. Take great care to not undermine the coach's authority.
5. Work for the good of the team and always give my best effort.
6. Show respect for the authority of the official, even though I will sometimes disagree with his/her calls.
7. Show good sportsmanship before, during, and after matches. I understand that volleyball is a game, and that the players on the other team are my opponents, not my enemies.
8. Be understanding of those who are less gifted by encouraging and helping them to improve- not belittle or discourage their performance.
9. I will do my best to help at youth volleyball events, including camps and clinics. I understand that the growth of our youth program will ultimately help the growth of our high school program.
10. Control my temper and not retaliate, even if I believe I have been wronged.
11. Not use or possess tobacco, vaping devices, alcohol, or illegal or performance-enhancing drugs.
12. THINK (is it True, Helpful, Inspiring, Necessary &/ Kind) before I post/text/share anything on social media or other platforms.
13. Help set-up and take down equipment before and after practices and games. I will not leave the work to my peers/coaches.
14. Be humble when I win and gracious when I lose.
15. Hold myself and my teammates accountable if these expectations are not being met.
