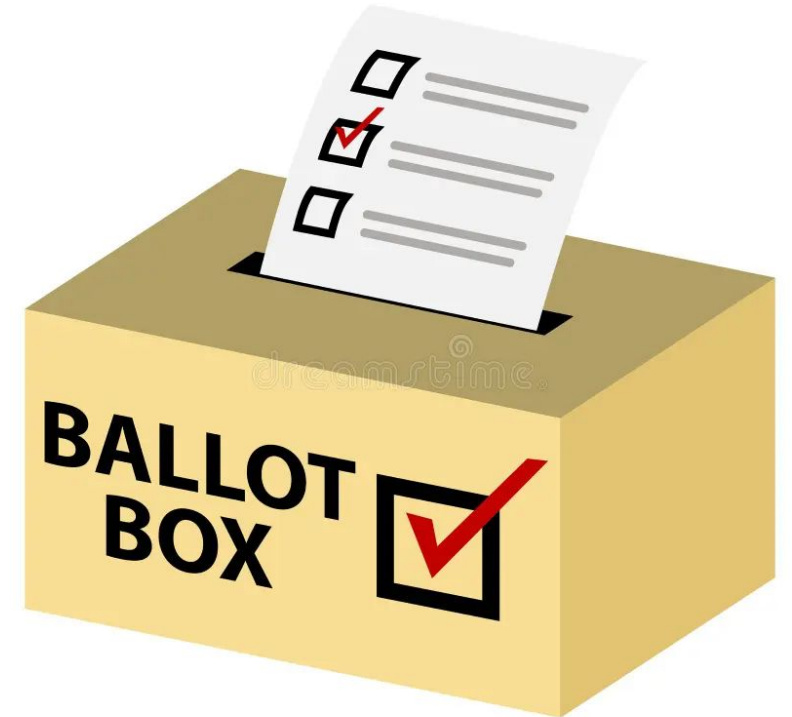

# Financial summary/highlights

- Ice time remains a great deal (\$100k flat fee). Continue to explore maximizing use.
- Large increase in revenues from last year (similar to 2023-2024 numbers)
  - Received several large donations and hosted state/guest games
    - As always, Mite Jamboree continues to be a big hitter, raising nearly \$15k
  - Concessions had great margins
    - Expenses stayed low (great job shopping for inputs, e.g., Amazon, Walmart, rather than going exclusively with 1 vendor)
    - More opportunities (Stout winning helps a lot!)
  - Had several additional fundraising opportunities that raised revenue (e.g., cooler raffle, baskets at Mite Jamboree and state)
    - Pull tabs were very popular and produce high margins
  - The cost of out of town tournaments continues to increase (some are \$1500); necessary?
- Wreath profit margin remained steady (41.8%); KT car wash cards continue to be an easy winner
  - Wreath/KT card buyout structure likely to change again next year
  - Opportunities for growth: corporate sponsorships, sign program, extra/voluntary fundraisers (such as cooler raffle)
- Started a Menomonie Hockey Endowment with the Community Foundation

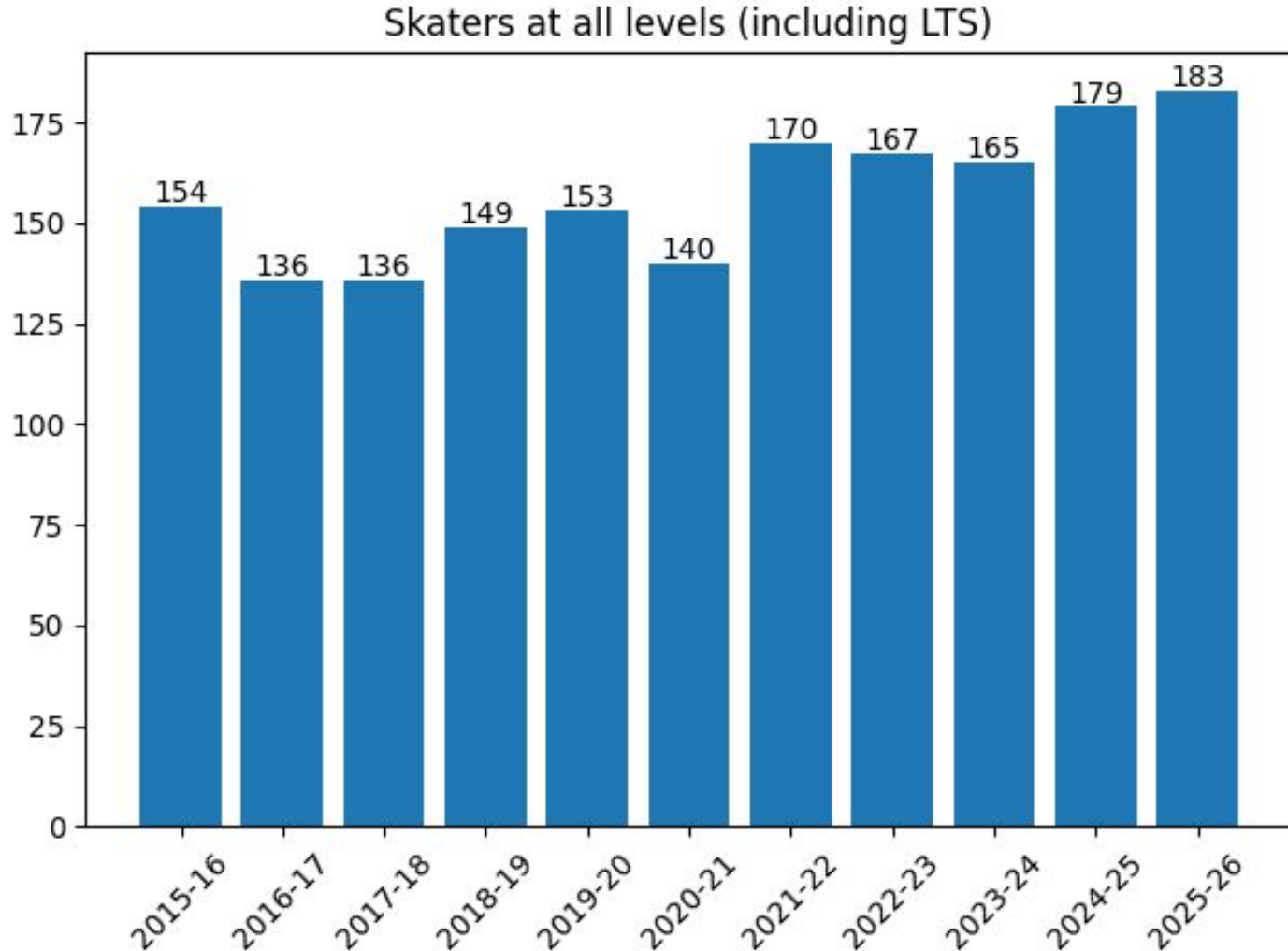

- Increase in girls participating and joining MYHA. Girls hockey one of the fastest-growing sports nation-wide.
- Huge increase in girls participating in the Co-Op U10-14 vs. MYHA

# Utilization & Maximization of WAP Hours



- Concessions and Open Skate did not have to be closed this year due to lack of staffing. Thank you!
  - However, multiple families put in *MANY* hours above and beyond while others have unmet requirements.
  - Invoices for unmet DIBS requirements will be sent in coming weeks.

## **Opportunity: WE STILL NEED MORE MEMBER HELP!!**

- DIB requirements and concession hours were increased, which may have helped with concessions staffing, but many committee openings remained.
- As a 100% VOLUNTEER ORGANIZATION we continue to need to find a way to share the load. Everyone needs to pitch in.
- We need to explore models of coverage for tournaments and playdowns.
