PAHL STANDING REPORTS:

DISCIPLINE

- 222 infractions which is a decrease from last year which was at 249.
- Decrease in misconducts at the 18U level but an increase at the 14U level.
- There has been an increase of 4 penalties in a game and fighting.
- Head contact has increased to a total of 19 in the last two weeks which is an increase.

EXECUTIVE ADMINSTRATOR

- Rules committee. Proposed rule book being reviewed. Hope to have for March to review and then vote on the following meetings. Looking at everything and may not be changing everything but looking at everything.
- Divisional standings. Standings are not accurate. Application of fair play points. Standing need to be right quickly. Continue using cell phone app to scan scoresheet within 20 mins of game. Then email to scoresheets@pahockey.com. Should not be walking off the ice without complete copies of the scoresheets. People in the box want to be there and have an idea of what they are doing. Online box score won't be there anymore. Looking at options of posting copies of scoresheet but that will come later. This is to cut down on errors and long term to see how it goes to evaluate it.
