DUEL IN DUBUQUE

LAST GAME - CHICAGO: The Steel fell 5-4 to the Dubuque Fighting Saints on April 2 at Fox Valley Ice Arena, snapping a five-game streak in which the Steel had earned at least a point. Neither team could reach the back of the net on the man advantage as the Steel went 1-for-1 (100%) on the penalty kill but registered an 0-for-4 (0.0%) night on the power play. Chicago was outshot 34-23 in the loss. Dubuque held the Steel off the scoreboard in the middle frame, just the fifth game this season Chicago had not reached the back of the net during the second period. **Sean Farrell** picked up a goal and an assist, claiming sole possession of the highest scoring single season in Chicago Steel franchise history. **Jack Harvey**, **Erik Middendorf** and **Adam Fantilli** each reached the back of the net in the loss. **Jack Stark** made 29 saves between the Steel pipes, his second-most stops recorded in a single game this season.

LAST GAME - DUBUQUE: The Fighting Saints held off the Chicago Steel, taking home a 5-4 victory on April 2 at Fox Valley Ice Arena in Illinois. The Fighting Saints notched a shorthanded goal while registering a 4-for-4 (100%) performance on the power play. With the win, Dubuque has earned points in their last six consecutive games. **Robert Cronin** scored twice for the Fighting Saints including a goal on the penalty kill that proved to be the game winner. **Primo Self**, **Henry Thrun** and **Ryan Alexander** each added a marker against the Steel. Netminder **Lukas Parik** stopped 19 shots to earn his 10th win of the season.

AGAINST THE FIGHTING SAINTS: The Steel have posted a 4-2-1-0 record in seven contests against Dubuque through the 2020-2021 regular season. Saturday's game concludes the eight-game regular season slate between the Eastern Conference foes. Chicago has earned a point in the standings in all three games at Mystique Community Ice Center this year with a 2-0-1-0 mark in three matchups.

FRANCHISE FARRELL: **Sean Farrell** claimed sole possession of the highest scoring season in Chicago Steel history with a goal and a helper on Friday night. The Harvard University commit and Montreal Canadiens prospect passed **Andrew Miller** (Steel 2007-2009) who registered 82 points (32G, 50A) during the 2008-2009 campaign for the top spot on the Steel all-time list. **Farrell** now has 84 points (26G, 58A) through 45 games played this season.

FIGHTING SAINTS FILE: Since March 13, Fighting Saints forward **Robert Cronin** has registered 16 points (10G, 6A) in nine games. In that stretch, five performances have been multi-point games including a five-point night (2G, 3A) on March 27 against the Waterloo Black Hawks. Defenseman **Henry Thrun** picked up a goal and a helper in the 5-4 win against the Steel on April 2. The Anaheim Ducks prospect has posted multi-point games in four of his last five outings for the Fighting Saints.
