5. Basketball

- a. Girls Season is over; jerseys and equipment has been returned to cage
- b. Boys end of season tournament is this weekend
 - i. we are hosting 3 games Friday 2/14 (530-830pm) and 7 games Saturday 2/15 (9am-3pm)

- ii. Cheerleader parents asked to work gate/concessions (S. Goedde is working on this)
The concession/gate spots have been fully filled by cheerleading parents. Katie will reach out to secure the scoreboard operators.

6. Spring Sports Updates

- a. Baseball - Baseball practice will start the first week of March, depending on weather.
- b. Softball - There are not enough 8th graders to fill a team, so the 7th/8th grade teams will be combined at this time should we not get additional signups. That will bring the combined team total to 17.

Katie will put a notification out that we need more 8th graders.

10 girls are interested in the softball clinic. There may be a large donation that will cover the expenses. The gym is reserved. The clinic will run on Sundays.

- c. Track - Track practice will be at LaSalle and will start 2/22. We've secured a third coach.

Parent concern was presented at the meeting regarding us not having a dedicated track and the K-8. If we want to continue this sport each year, we may want to start registration early so we can secure a better facility for the track students.

It was difficult to secure a track. We called multiple schools.

Parent will send name and number of contact at St I's. Katie can call St I's parish to see if it could be a mutual agreement between parishes due to the fact we do not offer high or long jump.
