

Director of Coaching and Player Development Omaha Hockey Club

The Director of Coaching and Player Development is responsible for the development of hockey coaches and players at all levels. The director is responsible for planning and executing a consistent process for coaching and player development and leadership. Other key duties include parent communication and community outreach. The position works in cooperation with the Executive Director and reports directly to the Board of Directors.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee coach selection for all teams at all levels.
- Assist with tryouts/league evaluations.
- Accept, evaluate and report to the BOD on all player move up requests.
- Spend time with all coaches on a regular schedule both on and off the ice.
- Develop and maintain an ongoing development process for all levels of the organization.
- Assist in development and maintenance of educational programs for the parents with emphasis in reinforcing the league philosophies.
- Work with the Schedule Director and all Program Directors to schedule practices.
- Work with the Registrar to monitor and maintain rosters.
- Develop and enforce an organization coaching set of rules, regulations, and philosophies as approved by the board.
- Attend 2-3 practices of each team for age levels above Mite to observe and provide an independent evaluation of players.
- Organize pre-season and in-season coach development sessions.
- Recruit coaches.
- Evaluate and observe coaches on a regular basis.
- Work to develop a vertical articulation of skills for players from IP to Highschool/AAA.
- Organize and coordinate the certification of coaches within the USA Hockey Coaching program.
- Work with the Tournament Director to recruit participants in OHC tournaments.
- Work with MWHL to organize our participation in MWHL and MW Select League.
- Attend Monthly Board meetings.
- Prepare reports as requested.
