Scouting Network Overview

- **The purpose of the Super Y League Scouting Network is to help identify players for the Top Prospect List as well as engage and empower current membership coaches in the SYL Philosophy:**
 - **To provide premier opportunities for every player to display their abilities and promote the best opportunities for each individual's growth and development.**
- **The SYL Scouting Network will be comprised of SYL club directors, coaches and scouts. This network will make recommendations on their own players, while also providing evaluations of players from other clubs to create a multi-faceted picture used to analyze talent from across the league and assist in forming the SYL Top Prospects List as well as helping to identify players for our pinnacle event, USL Experience in April.**
- **SYL scouts will be highly educated and seasoned coaches that have worked at the youth, collegiate and, preferably, the professional level.**

Scouting Network Overview (cont.)

Conduct:

- Coaches are representing the league and should conduct themselves accordingly. They should refer to the Super Y League operations manual for the standards of coaches as they apply toward scouts during competition and outside competition.

Expectations:

- Coaches involved in the SYL Scouting Network must name at least 1 of the top players from the **opposing team** each game on the final match report. In addition, after every 2 games coaches must fill out a Formstack naming the top performers from their own team.
- This is done so that there is adequate representation of unbiased evaluations of players across the league. **Recommendations regarding opposing players is highly valued within the Scouting Network Structure.**
- During the season, there will be on-going contact with the Super Y League Scouting Coordinator to discuss the progress of the scouting network as well as any updates taking place. All coaches participating in the SYL scouting network must be well qualified to identify top talent.
