# GRANTS

- **HSP regularly reviews and awards Grants across a wide array of categories. Some examples:**
  - EQUIPMENT for HHS (e.g. Wrestling Mats)
  - EQUIPMENT for Elementary Schools (e.g. Playground) and Middle School (e.g. Soccer Nets)
  - Help START UP NEW TEAMS (e.g. Youth Softball)
  - Help add COACHING Positions (JV Dance)
  - COMMUNITY based programs (e.g. Sponsor Road Race)
  - SNAP Summer Camp support
  
- **Sampling of Grants pertaining to Spring sports:**
  - Indoor Field Rental for Practices and Tryouts due to wet fields and weather (Variety of Sports)
  - Pitching Machine, Batting Cage and Support for Tennoji Trip (HHS Baseball)
  - Batting Cage (HHS Girls Softball)
  - Mental Toughness Workshop and JV Coach (HHS Tennis)
  - Unified Track Team Start Up (HHS Track)
  - Rugby Team Start up new team (HHS Boys Rugby)
