

Redwood Area Hockey Association Volunteer Policy

The Redwood Area Hockey Association (RAHA) is an organization run by volunteers. Volunteer efforts directly benefit RAHA players and families by setting a great example for our kids and offsetting program costs. The involvement of RAHA members is what makes this a successful organization.

Volunteer Policy: Each RAHA family is required to complete volunteer hours as specified by the RAHA Board of Directors each year. The only exception that exists is a family who has chosen to buy out their volunteer hours.

Examples of approved volunteer positions

- Concession Stands
- Score Keeper/Time Clock
- Penalty Box
- Varsity Ticket Sales
- Game/Event Clean-Up

*Hours may be completed at any RAHA event regardless of level of play. All volunteer hours will be tracked online using our "DIBS" program.

Volunteer Requirements:

- Mini Mite/Mite Level: 15 Hours
- Squirt Level and Above: 30 Hours

At the end of the season, if a family has not completed the volunteer commitment listed above, RAHA will invoice the family for the amount listed below. In the event that the volunteer requirement penalty is not satisfied, the player will not be able to register for the following season until the payment is made. No refund or credit will be given for hours worked.

- A penalty of \$25/hour for any unfulfilled hours will be levied for not meeting the Volunteer requirement per family.
- Families must have all hours completed by the end of the season.
- The RAHA Treasurer will send an invoice to any family who has not completed their hours.
- Players not meeting the requirement will not be allowed to register for the following hockey season until the payment is made in full and obligations have been satisfied.
