# Treasurer's Report

- Began year at \$14,968.33 – Currently at \$13,441.81 (Net **-\$1,526.52**)
- Does not include expenses from 2018 that cleared in 2019
- \$18,450 from dues
- Largest expense was officiating - \$13,080.20 – projected to grow due to two class system.
- Tournament expenses - \$8,425.53, Income - \$7,855.69 (Net **-\$569.84**)
- Awards - \$4,039.45 (Including Candi Parry Scholarship)
- Other miscellaneous expenses include operating costs, meals at meetings
- Medals vs T-Shirts for State Tournament

# Officials Payment Pilot Program

- Monthly invoices to teams for officiating fees
- Schools are going away from Arbiter
- Some officials are not getting paid in a timely manner
- To lessen burden on treasurers and parent volunteers
- Zionsville, HSE, Chatard, Plainfield, Penn, Northridge, and Brownsburg may be part of pilot

# By-Law & Competition Rule Proposals

1. Officials Representative to be a Voting Member of INGLA Board and Executive Committee - PASSED
2. Regular Season Game Limit - PASSED
3. Combine INGLA Secretary position with the Director of Communications/Marketing - PASSED
4. Sectional Tie-Breaking Procedures - PASSED
5. Amend By-Law Language - FAILED

# Regular Season Game Limit Rule

- Every INGLA Varsity and JV team are permitted to play a maximum of:
  - 2 preseason scrimmages (against other programs)

## \*9/16/19 Executive Board Update Regarding Scrimmages for Clarification Purposes:

Varsity = Four halves = 100 mins available to each Varsity team in preseason.

JV = Four halves = 80 mins available to each Junior Varsity team in preseason.

Scrimmages exception - you can play two scrimmages up until your first regular season game. This may be due to inclement weather or field availability/conditions. You can't scrimmage another team if they have already played a regular season contest.

- 18 regular season games with no tournaments, or
  - 17 regular season games with one tournament\*
- All regular season games (in-state and out-of-state) will count towards the team's total games from Opening Day until the Last Day of the Regular Season.
  - If you play in a regular season tournament over the course of 1-2 days, the tournament games will not:
    - be counted towards your season game total
    - the tournament wins/losses won't be counted towards your overall record.
  - As mentioned above, if your team plays in a tournament, you will only be allowed to schedule 17 regular season games. This mirrors the IHSA rule.
  - Teams will not schedule extra games in hopes that weather could result in cancellations.
  - Teams do not need to schedule the maximum number of regular season games. It is their discretion to schedule between 10-18.
  - Failure to follow this rule will result in playoff ineligibility.

# Officials Update

- Best Practices for Gameday weather issues
  - Text chain is preferred. If you may have game day weather issues start communication in the morning.
  - Must include both coaches, both of us and maybe more – get cell phone numbers.
  - Once changes are confirmed text ALL, including officials assigned on the games.
  - \*\*If you are also involved with a youth program, **just text Sheena and the other coach**. Sheena will contact officials, we don't want a bunch of unknown numbers texting the high school girls that officiate youth games.

# Officials Update

- Dealing with Officials

- Home team pays all officials. Play days - work it out before the game. If you are paying at the field please pay before the game or tell the official before the game how you will be paying and complete any tax forms you may need. Amounts are on arbiter. **We do not want officials waiting around after games.**
- Communication with officials – You can ask questions during a time out. They may not be able to answer you in the moment but will work to get an answer. **If you have issues please send clips.**
- I am very hard on the officials there is no need for coaches to be as well.
