- Wait time for officials when having to wait for games to be played – should there be compensation for this?
- To help keep/retain officials, one district provides bonuses to those that continue on to work further events
- Mentorship – Some districts would take a Friday to help experienced officials to mento students during game play
- Green Whistle/lanyard for new officials – that District would like to introduce to our new officials. Create a poster that will help notify spectators as to what this means. Plan will be to have them for April meeting.
- District level officials – top up pay from the District if they are not carded – they are paid the SVA level – members are encourage to register for SVA clinic/registration and they would be reimbursed the clinic fee once they worked a game during a championship.
