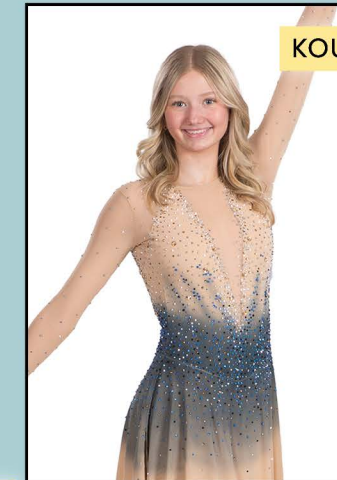

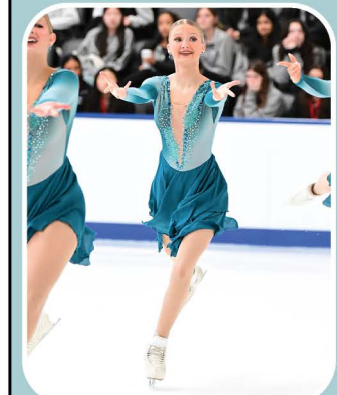

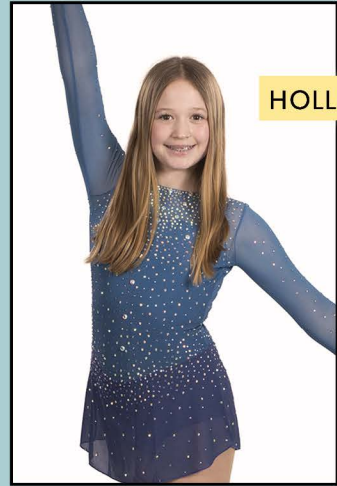

I have had the pleasure to be coached by Theresa Fleege, Alana Bianchi, Jillian Christie, Sam Kaplun, and Hailey Hipsher during recent years. Their endless support, unconditional love and patience has played a major role in my prosperity and success in skating. When I am not skating, I love to spend my time with friends and family boating, fishing, snowmobiling, traveling, tanning, and going for drives. I am committed to the University of St. Thomas Twin Cities and plan on majoring in business with a major in marketing and entrepreneurship.

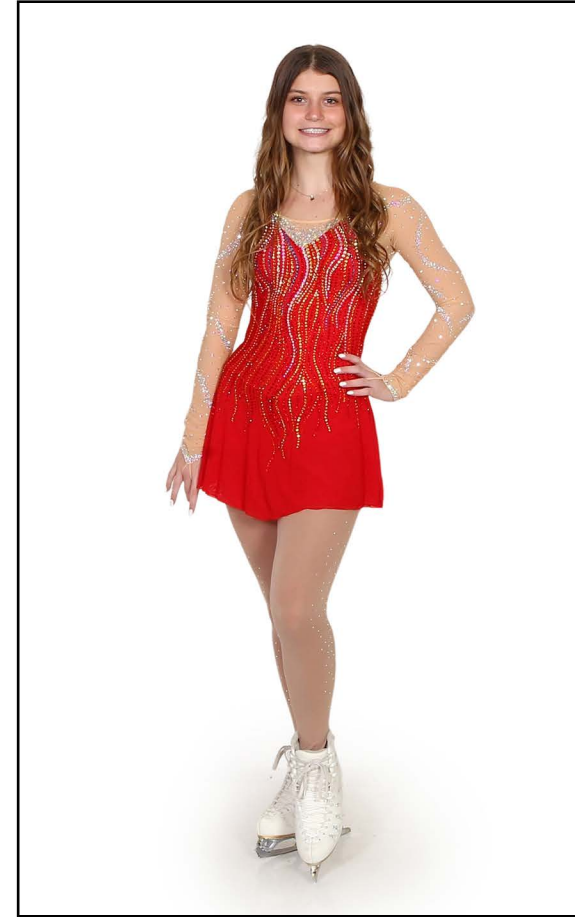
