- Officer / Committee Reports
 - Treasurer
 - Union County Foundation line item added – will reflect a month in the rears always
 - Youth registration – 83 boys and 31 girls currently signed up – numbers continue to grow
 - Insurance for youth leagues are paid
 - Weightroom balance has been paid for use for the year
 - Some lines may require an increase in the line items
 - Working to get a second paid coach through the school for middle school girls. If the school does not pay, POWER will pay, and the line item will need to be increased. Need to wait and see what the middle school does.
 - Looking to pay the school directly for coaches who are employed by the school, so they get paid throughout the season vs the end of season.
 - Updated signage for wrestling rooms –
 - Looking to add signage for the club programs, state placers, etc. Coaches are buying posters/stickers/etc and giving away to the students during the season. Power is looking to pay for these costs vs the coaches continuing the pay out of pocket for these.
 - Thanksgiving: buying 8 turkeys
 - Pay to play assistance – Ryan looking to get it done this week and shared out.
 - Adding stipulations to support the organization as requirement to get the assistance. Must volunteer 2 concession stand shifts to be eligible for assistance. High school has lots of events back-to-back in January we will need help with.
 - Assistance will be 50% or full \$200 cost.
 - Concession
 - Signup genius for concessions is complete and live, ready for sign-ups.
 - Wrestling is running the girls' basketball scrimmage concession stand.
 - First order placed.

 - Raymond baseball reached out, they have extra soda we are looking to buy from them.
 - In season fundraisers
 - Team Points Scored in Duals Boys – pledges for team points scored in duals.
 - Each wrestler gets a minimum of 5 sponsors.
 - Need POWER help to collect the money and create form.
 - Pending additional information from Nate before Power moves forward
 - Cornhole Toss @ Duals
 - Looking to use the high school fab lab to create the boards
 - Only have 3 duals at home – small fundraiser but could pick up movement for years to come.
 - Pay to play assistance:
 - If it's needed by a family, looking at making a stipulation that 2-3 concessions are signed up for to get assistance.
 - Assistance document will run through the Union County Foundation
 - Youth Wrestling Updates
 - Girls are not wrestling Helickson this year. A Central Ohio Girls Youth program was created for the 2025/2026 season
 - Shawn is pushing to have the Girls Championship housed at Marysville this year.
 - The schools will run the events since the 501C3 is not established.
 - POWER will order awards, etc for the Championship. Anything not used will be given to the organization to use moving forward once the 501C3 is created.
 - Still working out the best gyms and format since the program is new.
 - Delaware schools are pulling out of boys Helickson league as well, they are forming their own program.
 - No parents in the youth wrestling rooms for 2025/2026 season and moving forward.
 - 3rd – 6th grade – girls practice Tuesday/Thursday
 - K-2nd – Monday evenings
 - Some 5th and 6th graders will be moved up to wrestle with middle school girls (more experienced girls)

 - Folkstyle – minute and half periods – bigger weight allowance allowed (5lbs)

- Hydration Testing Q & A
 - Boys are 11/20
 - If there is a weight class the athlete knows they want to wrestle, you can only lose 1.5% of their bodyweight per week. It locks you in what you can wrestle each week.
 - A chart will be shared with high school parents to reference.
 - Boys – the lowest they can be is 7% below their body fat percentage.
 - Freshman athletes make the mistakes of over hydrating the day of – its important to hydrate right now in the weeks leading up to hydration testing.
 - Wrestlers cannot compete until the alpha testing is completed (hydration testing)
 - Girls are 11/22
 - Coaching Updates

 - Shawn made reservations for all the girls' overnight trips, to share with the parents ahead of time if they want to make arrangements at the same hotels.
 - Looking for someone to take over hospitality tables for boys/girls
 - Senior Nights

 - Youth girls at 30/31 currently
 - Saturday runs/breakfast happening – looking to add 1 a month throughout the summer and fall for 2026.
