


Things to do.


If using Google or Internet Explorer make sure pop up blocker is disabled.

To disable please follow the following.


Click the cogwheel icon top right like picture shows

Finding the test





Instructions to Test takers



Fill in the Name, Last name, Date of Birth and Gender


