PHILOSOPHY OF SPRING DEVELOPMENT & NOTES:

- Play other sports if possible – building athletes not hockey players at young age.
- Spring is about individual skill development NOT team.
- Off Ice workouts are encouraged
- For older kids (14U+) if you think you can play AAA go tryout in San Jose, if you don't make it come back. Stay away from AA hockey.
- Girls and Boys have their own clinics, drop in, and pick up. This is to limit numbers and be able to focus in on specific details pertaining to each game.
- Many older kids parents concerned about checking 14U. Checking specific clinics don't create the environment of a game. The focus from 10U-14U is LEARN THE GAME. Skating, passing and learning the game is what prepares you for checking. Your child has to go through a season to learn it. It is not something you learn in a clinic.

PICK-UP HOCKEY - \$140

Pick-Up hockey will consist of 1 hour 15-minute full ice games. THIS PROGRAM IS LIMITED TO 30 PLAYERS....15 PER TEAM + 2 goalies - 2 TEAMS PER AGE LEVEL. Upon registration, teams will be made (light vs dark) each week and adjusted as needed. Lines will be made for each team to compete against equal skill levels on the opposing team. A buzzer will indicate line changes so all lines will have equal time. A face off will start the game and then continuous play from there. Pick up hockey is Non-check. Players are encouraged to self-identify penalties and off-sides, when this happens a change of possession will occur. If any player is sabotaging the game experience through poor behavior (USA Hockey Code of Conduct) they will receive 1 warning. Upon a second offense, they will be removed from the program. There are no refunds for this program.
