



Ticket 2 Play

General Information

All Mount Pleasant High School students planning to participate in the athletic program at Mount Pleasant must complete the “Ticket 2 Play” process prior to trying out/practicing for any team. This process is REQUIRED to be completed prior to the beginning of each season. *Note: Multi-sport athletes will need to get a new “Ticket” for each season in which they plan to participate.*

The “Ticket 2 Play” process is in place for students to submit all required paperwork to the Athletic Department. Students will receive a “Ticket” once all of the required paperwork has been submitted and eligibility is verified. Students who are not eligible to participate in athletics, will not receive a “Ticket” and will not be permitted to try-out/practice.

“Ticket 2 Play” distribution for FALL SPORTS will take place from 9am-11am on July 28th & July 29th as long as all paperwork has been completed and updated physical. (If you turn in all paperwork before the FALL SPORTS PARENT MEETING, you will receive T2P that evening from your coach in breakout meeting)

The required NCHSAA physical form can be found by clicking on the “Documents and Forms” tab at www.cabarruscountyathletics.com/mountpleasanthts . To complete the “Ticket 2 Play” process you need to register for your sport at www.cabarruscountyathletics.com/mountpleasanthts and turn in/have on-file a complete, updated physical.

- ✓ Get Your “Ticket 2 Play”

After the “Ticket” has been issued, the student should give the “Ticket” to the head coach of the sport that they want to try-out/practice for. This will inform the coach that the student has turned in all required paperwork and is eligible to try-out/practice.
