Temporary Call-Up: Non-League Play

Occasionally a team may be short players for a tournament or non-league game. In such situation it is acceptable to ask a player at a lower level to temporarily play up. The upper level head coach will coordinate with the lower level coach on player selection. The JBH registrar will coordinate with the team manager to insure USA Hockey rosters are accurate.

- Per USA Hockey, Mites will not be approved for Temporary Call-Up to Squirt
- Per USA Hockey, players may be pulled up, but not down, unless the move is permanent
- Temporary call-up must be approved by the ACE and VP or President, as well as the parents of the player
- Registrar needs at least 72 hours to make changes to a roster. After January 1, the Registrar needs at least 7 days. If you do not have an approved roster at game time, do not let the player play in the game
