



## 2021 Homewood Baseball & Softball Season Plans

Updated September 10, 2021

1. This is a living document that will be changing and frequently updated based on recommendations from state and local governments. At any time, these league expectations will be adjusted based on modified state and local regulations and mandates. Please visit our website for the most up to date documentation.
2. Safe-practice and play guidelines will be met per the State of Illinois procedures, as updated in September of 2021.
3. All players, coaches and volunteers will be expected to read and sign our COVID waiver, which will be updated accordingly, and is available on the homepage of our website, at [www.HomewoodPlayball.com](http://www.HomewoodPlayball.com).
4. Registration fees will be charged upon registration. The league will do everything to mitigate any situations where we will need to hold back refunds, should the league be forced or choose to postpone or cancel the season. The Board will make decisions regarding uniform and equipment purchases utilizing the most current information available at the time.
5. All players, coaches and spectators MUST follow the posted COVID signage at all HBSL parks, including Izaak Walton, Apollo Park and all other facilities.
6. Visitors to our parks, including Izaak Walton, Apollo Park and all other facilities do not need to wear masks when outdoors. When indoors at our facilities, including bathrooms, all players, spectators and visitors MUST wear a mask. Players on the field may choose to wear a mask or not, based on personal preference. Players should stay six feet apart in the dugouts and on bleachers.
7. Teams will be provided with wipes, and sanitizer will be provided at Izaak Walton, but families should be prepared to supplement this with their own supplies.
8. Regarding visiting our sites, please use common sense and DO NOT participate if you are sick or not feeling well.
9. If a player or coach tests positive for COVID, or comes into close contact with someone who has tested positive, please use the same procedures that have been outlined by the Homewood School District and HF School District.
